I invite kind attention to the subject and references cited, and submit that the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, in Original Application No. 688 of 2018 filed by K. Lakshma Reddy, Vs M/s Siddi Vinayaka Oil Mills & Others has passed orders on 08.08.2019, directing the District Collector, Sangareddy to conduct health surveys and provide immediate relief to the inhabitants and cost thereof may be recovered from the industries out of the CSR funds and to furnish action taken report before the next date of hearing by e-mail i.e., by 13-11-2019 as the case is listed for consideration on 13-11-2019.

Accordingly, the District Medical and Health Officer, Sangareddy was instructed to conduct Health camps in the concerned villages. The District Medical and Health Officer, Sangareddy, has conducted the Health surveys and submitted the report through reference 3rd cited.

Sub:- Action Taken report of Health Camp conducted at Digwal village on 22nd Sep, 2019 – Submitting –Reg.

Ref:-Lr. No. H2/2346/2018 of Dist Collector Sangareddy dated 27th Aug, 2019.

With reference to the above cited subject, we conducted the Health Camp for the inhabitants of villagers surrounding Piramal Enterprises Ltd. Digwal, Kohir Mandal. The camp was conducted with help of A Dermatologist, General Physician and an Industrial Physician. X-Ray and Spirometry test were done to required patients for diagnosing chest diseases. 348 patients have utilised these services at camp. Out of these 96 patients have come with skin problems, 84 patients have come with Lung diseases and 168 patients with other general illness. Following are the various diseases diagnosed in the above patients.
