

**Action taken report on the order passed in OA No. 1011/2018
Jagdish Kumar vs State of Haryana dated 05.07.2019 by
Hon'ble NGT, Principal Bench, New Delhi.**

In reference to para 5 of the order dated 05.07.2019, the action taken on part of Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs is as below:

1. It is submitted that the scope of Solid Waste Management Services projects vary depending on the type of city, its geography, labour condition and the quality/quantity of waste generated in the city. Hence, it is difficult to standardise the rates at national level for such services. However, in order to support procurement efforts at state or ULB level, MoHUA has made SWM and sanitation items available on Government e-Market place (GeM) under “Swachh Bharat Mission” category. Ministry has also empanelled transaction advisors, institutes and agencies for providing support to the cities / towns for Solid Waste Management. All these guidelines and sample / model RFP / Concession Agreement documents are also made available in public domain on <https://swachhbharaturban.gov.in> portal.

2. It is also submitted that Ministry in association with UNIDO has taken steps to develop a National Level Solid Waste Management Vendor Registration module through an agency.
3. The Vendor module will facilitate registration of vendors providing services across the Solid Waste Management value chain (collection, transportation, processing and disposal). The information in the module will also include the nature and scope of the work and rates for such work etc. undertaken for various clients. This module will improve the success rate of the procurement process as the relevant information related to suitable vendors will be easily available to state / ULBs. It is also planned to include in the module, the functionality to rate vendors in order to create a feedback system whereby vendors will be accountable for the quality of services they provide.
4. The Vendor module is expected to be developed in three months.
