STATUS REPORT BY GREATER CHENNAI CORPORATION

IN O.A. No. 130 OF 2021

I, G. Veerappan, S/o. S. Ganapathy, Hindu, aged about 58 years, Superintending Engineer. Solid waste Management Department, Greater Chennai Corporation, having office at Chennai -600003, do hereby solemnly affirm and sincerely submit as follows.

1. I am working as the Superintending Engineer in the Greater Chennai Corporation and filing this report on behalf of the Commissioner, Greater Chennai Corporation and hence I am well acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case.

2. I respectfully submit that the sanitary workers Focus volunteers, Fever survey workers in all 15 Zones were provided with materials required to protect the front line workers as per Standard Operation Protocol. As per Government guidelines, during the first wave of Covid-19, 77,62,526 nos. of 3 Ply Mask, 4,04,950 nos. of cotton hand

gloves were issued to the sanitary workers in all 15 Zones from 01.04.2020 to 31.03.2021. I further submit that even during the 2nd wave of Covid-19, 7,80,170 nos. of 3 ply mask, 5000 nos. of cotton mask, 72,300 nos. of cotton gloves, 3,250 nos. of Rubber gloves, 7,013 nos. of Reflect - Jacket, 5,50,141 nos. of Yellow Bags for exclusive disposal of waste from the quarantined homes, and 200 nos. Of Gum Boots have been issued to all the sanitary workers. Also 5,06,050 nos. of 3 ply Mask, 1,28,800 nos. of cotton mask, 38,942 nos. N95 mask, 30,251 nos. of sanitizers, 41,342 nos. of Face Shield were issued to Fever Survey Workers and Focus Volunteers in all 15 Zones from 01.04.2021 - 23.08.2021, abiding the Standard Operation Protocols recommended by the Government.

3. I respectfully submit that as a measure to protect the sanitary workers, 15,584 nos of sanitary workers have been vaccinated. Beside vaccination, KabasuraKudineer was also distributed to all sanitary workers. And also medical camps for the sanitary workers were periodically conducted in Greater Chennai Corporation.

4. I respectfully submit that the Greater Chennai Corporation has signed agreement with two common Bio-Medical Waste TreatmentFacilities (CBWTF), M/s.Tamil Nadu Waste Management Pvt.Ltd., to collect covid 19 waste and biomedical waste from Zones 1 to 8 and M/s.G.J.Multiclave (India) Pvt.Ltd. from Zones 9 to 15 for the disposal of Covid-19 waste and biomedical waste. I further submit that during the second wave of Covid-19, the above CBWTFs have collected Covid 19 waste and biomedical waste as follows:



5. I respectfully submit that the Greater Chennai Corporation identifies the quarantined households and yellow bags are being issued to each quarantined household and collected separately by the sanitary worker and disposed through Common Biomedical Waste Treatment Facilities. In Valasaravakkam, Zone-11, the Covid-19 waste from quarantined households is being disposed of by M/s.G.J.Multiclave (India) Pvt.Ltd. Greater Chennai Corporation has issued 51,000 nos. of yellow bags to quarantined households in Zone -11.

6. I respectfully submit that the Greater Chennai Corporation has provided 50 nos. of CCTV Cameras in vulnerable locations of waste dumping and being viewed at integrated command and control centre established in Ripon Building and violators are being punished and penalized as per the Act.

7. I respectfully submit that the Greater Chennai Corporation is taking all efforts to stop the dumping of medical waste on the road sides. During nights Engineers of Greater Chennai Corporation are given duty to inspect night conservancy work and the illegal dumping of bio-medical waste is also being monitored. I further submit that the Greater Chennai Corporation had lodged a complaint in Valasaravakkam Police Station regarding the illegal dumping of medical waste on Sri Lakshmi Nagar, 3rd Street, in Division-149, Unit-33, Zone -11 vide Compliant No. 284/2021.

8. I respectfully submit that the Bio-medical waste was dumped in a private land abutting Alapakkam Main road in Division-147, Zone-11 of Greater Chennai Corporation on 09.08.2021 by INTER MED Tablet Manufacturing Company and was fined an amount of Rs. 5000/- by the Divisional Assistant Engineer.
