1.0 Preamble

In the matter of Original Application No. 131 of 2017(SZ) filed by Syed Mohamed Kalifa Sahib, joint committee comprising of the District Collector and Commissioner, Nagapattinam Municipality and District Environmental Engineer, Tamilnadu Pollution Control Board, Nagapattinam inspected the dumping yard located at Nagore Town and Nagapattinam Town on March 4th, 2020 and the committee report was submitted before Hon'ble NGT.

Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) Principal Bench, vide its order Dated August 06, 2020 has directed to submit updated report including the details of legacy waste, Bio methanization plant, Sewage treatment plant and action plan on Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016; in the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) Principal Bench the case listed on 27/10/2020.

2.0 Details of legacy waste in the dump yards located at Nagapattinam and Nagore Town

The extent of the legacy waste dumped in Nagapattinam site was 8.20 acres (34911M²) and in Nagore it was to an extent of 2.86 acres (11583M²).

After the inspection of the committee 2980M³ of legacy waste was processed and an extent of 1.20 acre land have been cleared. And further Bio – mining process is in progress now, and it is also planned

to clear the entire dumped legacy waste in Nagapattinam and Nagore dump site on or before 31.03.2021.

3.0 Status of Bio Methanization Plant and Sewage Treatment Plant

Bio – Methanization plant having a capacity of 5MT per day provided in Nagapattinam is now in operational condition and operated according to the availability of bio waste, which is near about 1.00 to 2.00 MT daily.


The installed STP in Nagapattinam with a capacity of 9.63 MLD is functioning upto the standard and maintained by the TWAD Board since from 2017.

The total extent of the legacy waste in Nagapattinam & Nagore dump site of 11.48 acres. So far 1.20 acre areas have been cleared and the remaining area will be processed and disposed on or before 31.03.2021. Necessary photos for the Bio – mining process are submitted to the Hon'ble court for the perusal.

The process will thus rectify the problem of the disposal of the legacy waste and also prevent further accumulation.
