I, Nandini Ghosh, daughter of Samir Dasgupta, aged about 55 years, by occupation - service, working for gain as Senior Special Secretary, Urban Development and Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal, having office at 'Nagarayan', DF -8, Sector - 1, Saltlake, Kolkata - 700064, do hereby solemnly affirm and state as under:-

1. That I am the Senior Special Secretary, Urban Development and Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal. I am well acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case and I have been duly

authorized to affirm this affidavit on behalf of the Secretary, Urban Development & Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal.

2. That I say that the Hon'ble, National Green Tribunal, has been pleased to pass an order dated 26.04.2024 constituting a Committee chaired by the Principal Secretary Department of Urban Development and Municipal Affairs, Government of West Bengal and directing the Committee to submit a report.

3. That I state that in compliance with the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 26.04.2024, a meeting has been arranged and was chaired by Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department on 13.06.2024 with all the Committee members including Department of Urban Development and Municipal Affairs.

**The photocopy of the Meeting Notices along with the Minutes of the meeting of the Committee dated 13.06.2024 and attendance sheet have been collectively enclosed herewith and marked as Annexure A.**

4. That I say that the decisions taken in the Meeting dated 13.06.2024 states inter-alia that:

***(a) Short Term measures are as follows:***

*A. It has been decided to go for simultaneously Health check up program for the residents living near the embankment, cleanliness drive to remove garbage heaps on canal banks and public outreach, IEC activity for developing awareness among the people towards the importance and necessity Solid and Liquid Waste Management.*

***[Action: KMC].***

*B. Placement of garbage bins and regular collection/cleaning of Municipal Solid Waste will be done with regard to Solid Waste*

Management. Steps should be taken for prohibiting open garbage dumping [**Action: KMC**].

C. The Health Department under KMC may continue applying insecticides on regular basis in the Circular Canal and also cultivation of the Gappi Fishes may be done to reduce spreading of vector-borne diseases [**Action : KMC**].

D. The Irrigation & Waterways Department, the Kolkata Municipal Corporation will take necessary action to clean the floating garbage and the dumped garbage over the canal slopes respectively. [**Action: I & W Department; KMC**].

E. Dredging of Circular Canal will be carried on and continued by Irrigation & Waterways Department as per their existing plan. [**Action: I & W Department**].

F. Both side fencing (Galiff Street on left bank and P.K. Mukherjee Road on right bank) along the accessible and open stretch of the canal bank will be initiated by Irrigation & Waterways Department [**Action: I & W Department**].

G. It was decided that, a survey will be conducted by Kolkata Municipal Corporation in a suitable manner to ascertain the number of encroachers and the nature of encroachment (residential/ commercial). The exercise will also capture the socio-economic status and the livelihood pattern. This will help to understand the nature and extent of the encroachment so that a future strategy could be formulated. At the same time, the number of existing drain-outfalls on both banks of the affected stretch of Circular Canal may be identified to conceptualize and implement the upcoming Liquid Waste Management Project(s)

*catering to the volume of sewage being discharged through these outfalls.*

*KMC will submit a comprehensive report on all the above decision points for the purpose of filling affidavit before Hon'ble NGT.*

**(b) Long Term Measures:**

- A. A detailed Action Plan may be chalked by KMC under the supervision of UD & MA Department within 3-6 months to address the issue of encroachment, rehabilitation, etc.*
- B. UD&MA Department/WBSPMG will find out feasible means to mitigate the pollution issue by way of on-spot treatment of sewage to bring down Faecal Coliform-content and BOD as well. WBPCB has been requested to guide and help the UD&MA Department and WBSPMG with suitable low cost technology in this regard and the Action Plan will also include how to improve the water quality upon installation of suitable waste water treatment facility for the existing sewer outfalls by incorporating the guidance of WBPCB.*

***[Action: KMC, I&W Department and Kolkata Police, WBPCB,  
UD&MA Department and WBSPMG]***

**(c) Other considerations:**

- A. Irrigation & Waterways Department will extend the coverage zone of Action Plan with respect to fencing upto R.G. Kar Bridge beyond B.T. Road Bridge.*
- B. The Bye-election of Maniktala Assembly Constituency is scheduled to be held on 10th July, 2024 and a part of Galiff Street falls within this*

*constituency. So, Long Term Measures as per the proposed action plan will be undertaken ast the end of election process.*

***[Action: Irrigation and Waterways Department, UD&MA Department]***

5. I say that with regard to the decision points of the Meeting dated 13.06.2024, the Kolkata Municipal Corporation has submitted a report vide an email dated 06.07.2024. It appears from the report of KMC (annexed at **Annexure B**) that-

**Joint Survey by KMC, I&WA Department, GoWB and Local P.S.**

*Survey is going on by the team of KMC, I&WA Deptt., Go.W.B. and Local P.S. The area in question is thickly populated engaged in various types of occupations. So far field survey has been conducted and 130 households/units have been enumerated on the northern bank of the canal having various types of occupations. The survey work is in progress. The datasheet of the survey so far conducted is attached herewith.*

**Report of SWM Department, KMC dated 06.07.2024**

*In compliance with the order duly passed by the Hon'ble NGT dated 29.11.2023 in connection with the above referred OA no. and subsequent direction of UD & MA Department, Govt. of West Bengal, departmental inspection caused at case site on 09.12.2023, 16.4.2024 and 6.7.2024.*

*The Solid Waste Management (SWM) department of **the Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC)** provides conservancy Services at the **Galiff Street** to keep neat and clean on regular basis.*

*About 20 nos. 240 liter trash bins had been provided there. For primary collection of waste from households of that area, about 430 nos 10 liter trash bin had also been provided. For general awareness of cleanliness of within the*

locality, SWM department has hoarded banner at several places, distributed leaflets and miking had done with the help of Health Department.

Minutes of the meeting of the Committee constituted by Hon'ble NGT in pursuance of its order dated 26.04.2024 in Original Application No.158/2023/EZ [In Re: "Banks of the Circular Canal are getting "Stolen" regularly near Galiff Street: wastes and garbage spreading pollution" – News item published in Bartaman, Daily Bengali Newspaper, dated 15.10.2023, Kolkata] on 13/06/2024 at 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Conference Hall, Jalasampad Bhawan, Saltlake, Kolkata - 700091.

The meeting was chaired by Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department. He welcomed all the members and other Officials and briefed about the directive(s) of Hon'ble NGT, EZB, Kolkata.

At the outset, upon request of the Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department, Senior Special Secretary, UD& MA and Program Director, WBSPMG presented the current status through a PPT on the Pollution matter of Circular Canal near Galiff Street due to indiscriminate disposal of liquid and solid waste by the canal-bank dwellers/encroachers.

Thereafter, Irrigation and Waterways Department presented their own report through a PPT about the present encroachment status therein and upcoming fencing projects in connection with Circular Canal starting from B.T.Road Bridge on the upstream upto the Chitpur Bridge.

WBPCB also arranged a presentation displaying a *drone survey* conducted over the entire stretch right from R. G. Kar Bridge on the upstream to the confluence beyond the Chitpur Bridge from which it appeared that the water quality of Circular Canal flowing towards River Ganga needs immediate attention. Chairman, WBPCB drew the attention of all present in the meeting to give special emphasis on Faecal Coliform-content.

At the end of all presentations, Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department suggested for setting up STP/FSTP suitably to mitigate the pollution of Circular Canal. He emphasized on preparation of an Action Plan with Short-Term as well as Long-Term measures.
