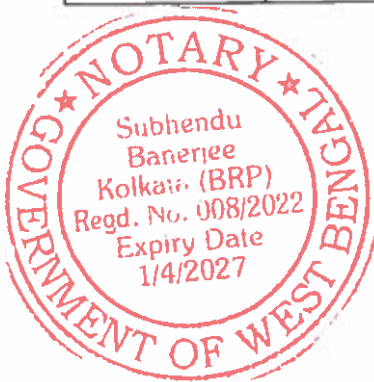

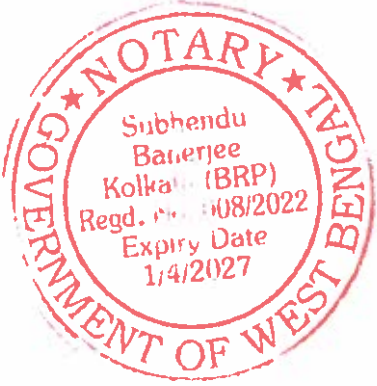

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AFFIDAVIT ON BEHALF OF THE URBAN DEVELOPMENT & MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT, GOVERNMENT OF WEST BENGAL

I, Nandini Ghosh, daughter of Samir Dasgupta, aged about 55 years, by occupation - service, working for gain as Senior Special Secretary, Urban Development and Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal, having office at 'Nagarayan', DF -8, Sector - 1, Saltlake, Kolkata - 700064, do hereby solemnly affirm and state as under:-

1. That I am the Senior Special Secretary, Urban Development and Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal. I am well acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the case and I have been duly authorized to affirm this affidavit on behalf of the Secretary, Urban Development & Municipal Affairs Department, Government of West Bengal.

2. That I say that the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, has been pleased to pass an order dated 26.04.2024 constituting a Committee chaired by the Principal Secretary Department of Urban Development and Municipal Affairs, Government of West Bengal and directing the Committee to submit a report and in compliance with the said Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 26.04.2024 a meeting has been arranged and was chaired by Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department on 13.06.2024 with all the Committee members including Department of Urban Development and Municipal Affairs and thereafter a report has been submitted before Hon'ble NGT on 09.07.2024.

3. That I state that in pursuance of the order dated 26.04.2024 and 10.07.2024, the 2nd Meeting of the Hon'ble NGT constituted Committee has been chaired by the then Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department on 13.08.2024 with all the Committee members including Department of Urban Development and Municipal Affairs.

The photocopy of the Meeting Notice along with the Minutes of the review meeting of the Committee dated 13.08.2024 have been collectively enclosed herewith and marked as Annexure A.

4. That I say that the decisions taken in the Meeting dated 13.08.2024 may be stated *inter-alia* as follows:

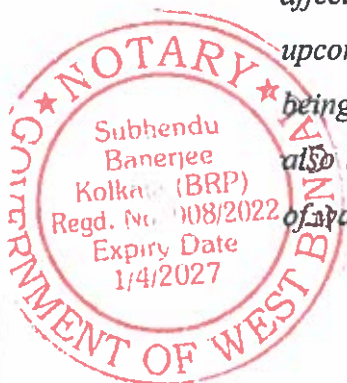
(a) Short Term measures are as follows:

A. *It has been decided to continue with the Cleanliness Drive to remove garbage heaps on canal banks and public outreach & undertake IEC activity through miking, postering, leaflet, etc. for developing awareness among the people towards the importance and necessity of Solid and Liquid Waste Management. [Action:*

- B. *With regard to Solid Waste Management, KMC will continue and strengthen its conservancy services at the Galiff Street to keep the area neat and clean on regular basis. Placement of suitably anchored garbage bins or possibility of holding down the bins by other technology may be explored to prevent theft/burglary of garbage bins, as noticed. Additionally, KMC may explore to set up Compactor Station(s) on/near the bank of Circular Canal adjoining Galiff Street [Action: KMC].*
- C. *The Health Department under KMC may initiate and continue public awareness program regarding vector-borne diseases, etc. and may also continue with health checkup program for the residents living near the embankment.[Action : KMC].*
- D. *The I&W Department may explore the scope for beautification, development and fencing over the both side-railings of bridges and both banks of Circular Canal along Galiff Street to minimize garbage dumping. [Action: I&W Department].*
- E. *The Irrigation & Waterways Department may continue with removing of the floating garbage and cleaning of the dumped garbage over the canal slopes respectively. [Action: I & W Department].*
- F. *Dredging of Circular Canal may be continued by I&W Department as per the prevailing Plan of the Department. [Action: I & W Department].*
- G. *Both side fencing (Galiff Street on left bank and P.K. Mukherjee Road on right bank) over & along the accessible and open stretches of the canal bank will be initiated by Irrigation & Waterways Department as earliest and the Department may explore the possibilities to extend the coverage zone of Action Plan further towards erection of fencing on both banks upto R.G. Kar Bridge beyond B.T. Road Bridge. [Action: I & W Department].*
- H. *It has been decided that, a Joint Survey will be conducted by KMC, I&W Department, WBPCB, WBSPMG and other concerned stakeholders on and from 14.08.2024 to identify & ascertain the existing drain-outfalls on both banks of the affected stretch of Circular Canal in order to conceptualize and implement the upcoming Liquid Waste Management Project(s) catering the volume of sewage being discharged through these drain-outfalls. At the same time water samples may also be collected from these drains at the respective outfalls to analyse the gravity of water pollution in those tributary drains—the overall effluent quality of Circular*



Canal is tested /analyzed by WBPCB on regular basis. I&W Department with the help of Local Police Station and KMC may also identify suitable land-pocket(s) at nearby locations with regard to implementation of the rehabilitation, etc. [Action: KMC, I&W Department and Kolkata Police, WBPCB and WBSPMG]

I. With reference to the available map, pictorial overview of the affected stretch of Circular Canal may be drafted mentioning about the land use and development plan. [Action: I&W Department]

KMC will submit a comprehensive Report to UD&MA Department with colour photographs and datasheets (if applicable) on all the above decision points along with the House-to House Survey reports mentioning inter-alia the number of encroachers and the nature of encroachment (residential/commercial), the socio-economic status and the livelihood pattern, drains/outfalls on both banks of the affected stretch of Circular Canal, etc. for the purpose of filling affidavit before Hon'ble NGT.

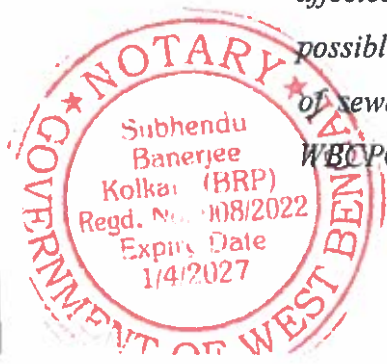
I&W Department will provide a Report with colour photographs to UD & MA Department for the purpose of filling affidavit before Hon'ble NGT.

WBPCB will provide the Water Quality Reports for the purpose of filling affidavit before Hon'ble NGT.

WBSPMG will provide a Report highlighting the installation/repairing of penstock gates catering issues of the affected stretch of Circular Canal near Galiff Street.

(b) Long Term Measures:

- A. A detailed Action Plan may be chalked out by KMC under the supervision of UD & MA Department within 3-6 months post completion of all the survey to address the issues relating to encroachment, rehabilitation, etc.
- B. Post completion of the survey regarding, drains/outfalls on both banks of the affected stretch of Circular Canal, UD&MA Department/WBSPMG may find out possible/feasible means to mitigate the pollution issue by way of on-spot treatment of sewage, etc. to minimize Faecal Coliform-content and BOD level as well. WBPCB has been requested to guide and help the UD&MA



Department/WBSPMG with suitable low cost technology in this regard so that the Action Plan may include the proposed plan to improve the water quality upon installation of suitable waste water, sewage treatment facilities for the existing sewer outfalls by incorporating the guidance of WBPCB. I&W Department may provide suitable space, if available, for the purpose of installation of suitable waste water, sewage treatment facilities. Action Plan may also include land issues, scope of funding, etc. along with the proposed tentative timelines.

[Action: KMC, I&W Department and Kolkata Police, WBPCB, UD&MA Department and WBSPMG]

5. I say that with regard to the decision points of the Meeting dated 13.08.2024, the Kolkata Municipal Corporation has submitted their reports. It appears from the reports of KMC that-

Joint Survey by KMC, I&WA Department, GoWB and Local P.S.

Survey work around Circular Canal near Gallif Street has been done by the team of KMC, I&WA Deptt., Go.W.B. and Local P.S. The area in question is thickly populated engaged in various types of occupations. The datasheet of the survey has been attached herewith.

Report of Health Department, KMC vide an email dated 30.09.2024

The Health Department, KMC had provided their report along with the reports on Special Health Camps for Residents of Circular Canal Bank in ward 7.

The Health Department, KMC, in their report dated 24.08.2024 had mentioned inter-alia that the Health Department of KMC had completed four Health camps for residents living on the slope and banks of circular canal on 16.08.2024, 17.08.2024, 20.08.2024 and 21.08.2024 respectively.

The photocopy of the reports as received from the Kolkata Municipal Corporation have been collectively have been collectively enclosed herewith and marked as Annexure B.



6. That I say that with regard to the decision points of the Meeting dated 13.08.2024, the WBSPMG has submitted a Joint Inspection Report dated 14.08.2024. It appears from the Joint Inspection Report dated 14.08.2024 that-

A Joint inspection with Kolkata Police (Chitpur PS & Shyampukur PS), WBPCB, KMC (S&D Deptt.), I&W Deptt. and WBSPMG was held on 14.08.2024 to identify and observe the existing sewer outfalls in Belegkata Circular Canal in between Chitpur Lock Gate and R. G. Kar Bridge. According to the decisions taken in the meeting under the Chairmanship of Addl. Chief Secretary, I&W Department dt. 13.08.2024, WBPCB joined the inspection to collect the water sample from the outfalls before discharge in the canal.

Within the premises of Chitpur Lock Gate (I&Ww Deptt.), one outfall on the southern bank was found (without discharge) in dry condition.

The next outfall with a penstock gate was found adjacent to the Galiff Street Pumping Station on the southern bank along Galiff Street. WBPCB collected the water sample from this outfall with the help of KMC people.

Another dry gated outfall on the upstream was found in dry condition beside the Park on Galiff Street.

The next sample was collected at one gated outfall (upstream) on Southern flank of Canal West Road (Raj Ballav Street).

The last sample collection was done at the ungated outfall adjacent to R.G. Kar Bridge at Manmatha Nath Ganguly Street on the Northern bank.

The photocopy of the Joint Inspection Report dated 14.08.2024 is enclosed herewith and marked as Annexure C.



7. That I say that with regard to the decision points of the Meeting dated 13.08.2024 and with reference to the Joint Inspection Report dated 14.08.2024,

the WBPCB has submitted the Test Reports dated 20.08.2024 with regard to the water samples collected from different places of the said canal.

The photocopy of the report as received from WBPCB have been collectively enclosed herewith and marked as Annexure D.

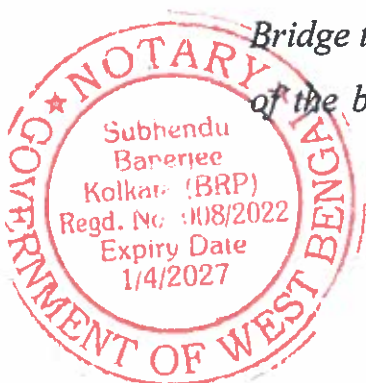
8. That I say that with regard to the decision points of the Meeting dated 13.08.2024, the office of Executive Engineer –I, Canal Division, Irrigation and Waterways Directorate under the Irrigation and Waterways Department has also provided their report vide Memo No. 3209 dated 05.11.2024. The report as received from the Executive Engineer –I, Canal Division stated *inter-alia* as follows -

- a. *A scheme of fencing for 280 m along both banks of Circular Canal near Gallif Street (65 m of Gallif Street on left bank & 215 m of P. K. Mukherjee Road on right bank) at a cost of Rs. 27.56 lakh has been prepared and is, at present, under appraisal at the I & W Department for accordance of Administrative Approval & Financial Sanction. The fencing work has been proposed on the open spaces in between some public and private properties like KMC pump house, Pay & Use toilets, KMC building, KMC garden, building of Ramkrishna Mission etc. However, it is to mention here that there are considerable encroachments within the entire stretch of Circular Canal from Chitpur Bridge to B.T. Road Bridge not only on the above stated open spaces of the bank but also on the slope and sometimes even extending on the bed of the canal. Unless the said encroachments are removed piecemeal fencing will not give derived result. The bridges i.e. Chitpur Bridge, B. T. Road Bridge & R. G. Kar Road Bridge over Circular Canal do not belong to the I&W Department. Beautification work along both banks of Circular Canal will*



be implemented on the encroachment free available spaces on the canal side of proposed fencing.

- b. Floating materials from the Canal are being cleaned regularly through annual maintenance contract.
- c. Dredging of Circular Canal for the entire length of 1.20 km was completed during 2021-2022. At present no dredging is required at this stretch. However, dredging of Beliaghata Khal from Chingrighata to Gajnavi Bridge is ongoing, which will help in improving drainage through Circular Canal.
- d. As pointed out already under Sl. No. (1) above it is reiterated that a scheme of fencing for 280 m along both banks of Circular Canal near Gallif Street (65 m of Gallif Street on left bank & 215 m of P. K. Mukherjee Road on right bank) at a cost of Rs. 27.56 lakh has been prepared and is, at present, under appraisal at the I & W Department for accordance of Administrative Approval & Financial Sanction. Another scheme of fencing for 655 m amounting to Rs. 64.28 lakh along both banks of Circular Canal beyond B.T. Road Bridge up to R.G. Kar Road Bridge (280 m of Canal West Road on left bank & 375 m of M. N. Ganguly Road on right bank) has also been prepared and is under examination at Irrigation & Waterways Directorate. Here it may also be mentioned that the fencing work has been proposed on the open spaces in between some public utilities like KMC valve station, Pay & Use toilets etc. However, it is to mention here that there are considerable encroachments within the entire stretch of Circular Canal from B.T. Road Bridge to R.G. Kar Road Bridge not only on the above stated open spaces of the bank but also on the slope and sometimes even extending on the



bed of the canal. Unless the said encroachments are removed piecemeal fencing will not give derived result.

- e. Authority of KMC has been requested on 30.10.2024 to conduct a joint survey to identify the drain-outfalls on both banks of the affected stretch of Circular Canal and land-pocket(s) at nearby locations with regard to implementation of rehabilitation etc.
- f. Pictorial overview of the affected stretch of Circular Canal has been appended with the report.
- g. I & W Department will explore the availability of surplus land for the purpose of installation of suitable waste water, sewage treatment facilities, once the locations of such waste water and sewage treatment plants are finalized by KMC.

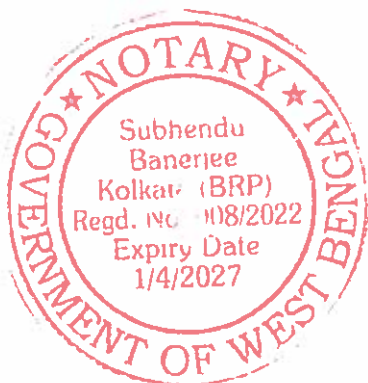

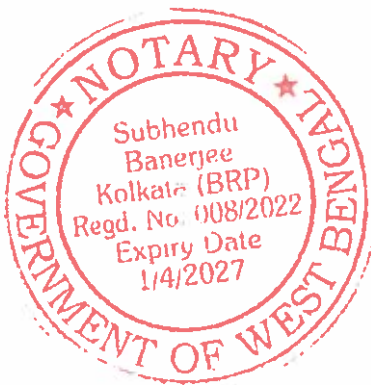

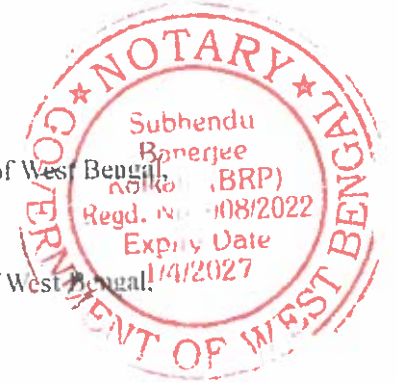

Minutes of the 2nd Meeting of the Hon'ble NGT constituted Committee in pursuance of the order dated 26.04.2024 passed by Hon'ble NGT in Original Application No.158/2023/EZ [In Re: "Banks of the Circular Canal are getting "Stolen" regularly near Galiff Street: wastes and garbage spreading pollution" – News item published in Bartaman, Daily Bengali Newspaper, dt. 15.10.2023, Kolkata] chaired by the Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department, GoWB on 13/08/2024 at 1st Floor Conference Hall, Jalasampad Bhawan, Salt Lake, Kolkata- 700091.

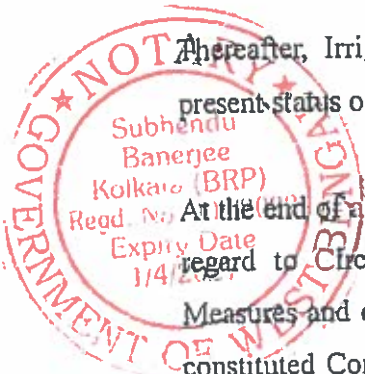
The meeting was chaired by Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department. He welcomed all the members and other Officials and briefed the directives of Hon'ble NGT, Eastern Zone Bench, Kolkata.

At the outset, upon request of the Additional Chief Secretary, Irrigation and Waterways Department, Senior Special Secretary, UD & MA Department and Program Director, WBSPMG presented a PPT with regard to the decision taken in the 1st Meeting of the Hon'ble NGT-constituted Committee held on 13.06.2024.

Thereafter, Kolkata Municipal Corporation (KMC) presented its Report highlighting inter-alia the latest update with regard to Joint Survey by KMC, Irrigation and Waterways Department and Local Police Station in connection with the area in question. KMC further highlighted that the area in question is thickly populated and occupants residing therein are engaged in various types of occupations. KMC also mentioned that as per field survey, about 400 households/units have been enumerated on the Northern bank of the canal while about 300 households/units have been enumerated on the Southern bank of the canal. The dwellers have various types of occupations. The survey work has almost been completed. The datasheet of the survey was also presented through a PPT.

Thereafter, Irrigation and Waterways Department also had a presentation displaying the present status of dredging of Circular Canal.

At the end of all presentations, a threadbare discussion was held for resolving the issues with regard to Circular Canal near Galiff Street through Short Term Measures, Long Term Measures and other considerations, as per the MoM of the 1st Meeting of the Hon'ble NGT-constituted Committee held on 13.06.2024, in terms of the directives of Hon'ble NGT. 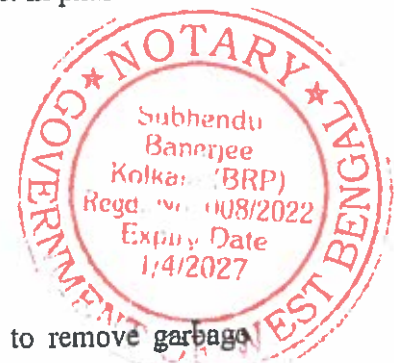

WBCPCB has been requested to guide and help the UD&MA Department/WBSPMG with suitable low cost technology in this regard so that the Action Plan may include the proposed plan to improve the water quality upon installation of suitable waste water, sewage treatment facilities for the existing sewer outfalls by incorporating the guidance of WBPCB. I&W Department may provide suitable space, if available, for the purpose of installation of suitable waste water, sewage treatment facilities. Action Plan may also include land issues, scope of funding, etc. along with the proposed tentative timelines.

 - Regular vector control works done with anti-larval spray and source reduction of mosquito breeding place.

 - Surveillance of any health-related issue and disease monitoring.



B) In the KMC area, Beliaghata Circular Canal and many other sewerage canals are a big perennial source of mosquito, especially the ones belonging to the species Culex quinquefasciatus.

When people of Kolkata City complain about increased mosquito nuisance, they actually mean the nuisance caused by Culex mosquito.

To control the menace of Culex mosquito, the Health Department of KMC has since 2011 been carrying out larvicidal spray along different mosquitogenic canals by using rowing boats as transport.

Currently, the KMC is doing the said larvicidal spray in canals by using 20 KMC -owned rowing boats, covering 39 wards of KMC.

Since Culex mosquito can fly 5 kms, people living in another 33 wards are indirectly benefitting from this KMC-sponsored Culex control project. This needs to be remembered that this Culex control effort of KMC is first-of -its-kind initiative in India.

Thus, the total no of KMC wards getting benefits from the rowing boat-aided larvicidal spray in canals stands at 72.

As regards use of guppy fish, the vector control squads of KMC release such larvivorous fish whenever and wherever required.

Pertinently, the irrigation and Waterways Department of Govt. of West Bengal has already undertaken the initiative for cleaning Beliaghata Circular Canal, etc. This cleaning will help the KMC run its Culex control project quite smoothly.

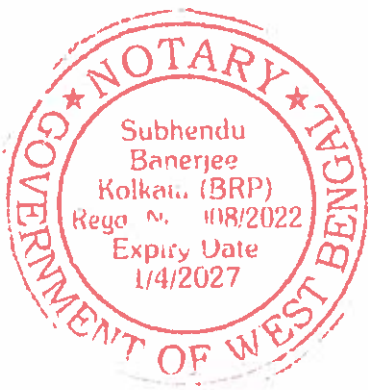

Joint Inspection Report on the existing Sewer Outfalls in Belegghata Circular Canal, 14.08.2024

A Joint inspection with Kolkata Police (Chitpur PS & Shyampukur PS), WBPCB, KMC (S&D Deptt.), I&Ww Deptt. and WBSPMG was held on 14.08.2024 to identify and observe the existing sewer outfalls in Belegghata Circular Canal in between Chitpur Lock Gate and R. G. Kar Bridge. According to the decisions taken in the meeting under the Chairmanship of Addl. Chief Secretary, I&Ww Department dt. 13.08.2024, WBPCB joined the inspection to collect the water sample from the outfalls before discharge in the canal.

Within the premises of Chitpur Lock Gate (I&Ww Deptt.), one outfall on the southern bank was found (without discharge) in dry condition.

The next outfall with a penstock gate was found adjacent to the Galiff Street Pumping Station on the southern bank along Galiff Street. WBPCB collected the water sample from this outfall with the help of KMC people.

Another dry gated outfall on the upstream was found in dry condition beside the Park on Galiff Street.

The next sample was collected at one gated outfall (upstream) on Southern flank of Canal West Road (Raj Ballav Street).

The last sample collection was done at the ungated outfall adjacent to R.G. Kar Bridge at Manmatha Nath Ganguly Street on the Northern bank.

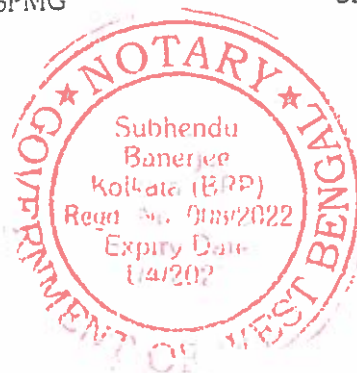
The Joint Inspection dt. 14.08.2024 came to an end due to bad weather conditions.

[During today's inspection, we entered the KMDA's Sewage Pumping Station on Galiff Street—pumps were in operation. Subsequently, the concerned AE (E&M), KMDA was contacted to know the function modality of this Pumping Station. It is essential to know the function of this PS/LS because the combined (DWF+SWF) flow generated over the adjacent localities of KMC wards 7 and 8 are diverted to this Pumping Station, as it is learnt, but no clarity/ clear conception about the discharge of this Pumping Station is obtained so far from GAP Sector, KMDA. The instant PS/LS is directly associated with the Pollution Abatement matter about Belegghata Circular Canal at the Galiff Street Areas].

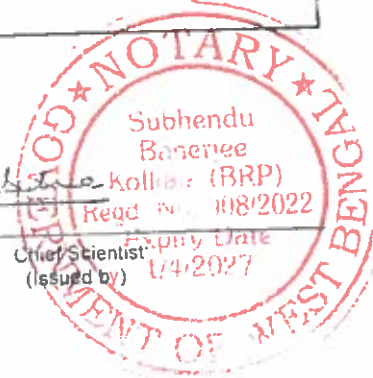

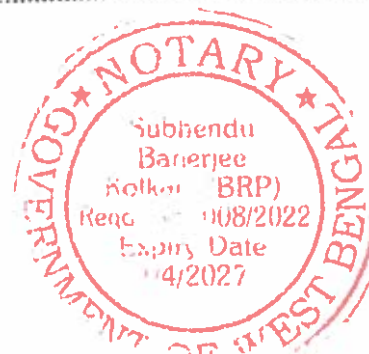

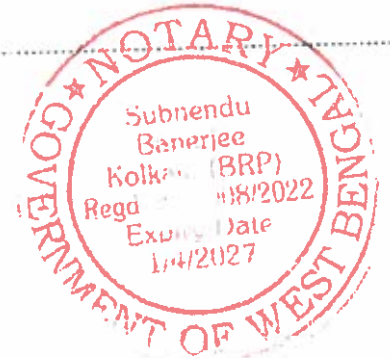

In reference to above the actions taken by Canals Division, Irrigation & Waterways Directorate near Gallif Street and also up to R. G. Kar Road Bridge beyond B. T. Road Bridge in connection with the meeting of the Committee held on 13.08.2024 are mentioned below seriatim:

1. (a) D

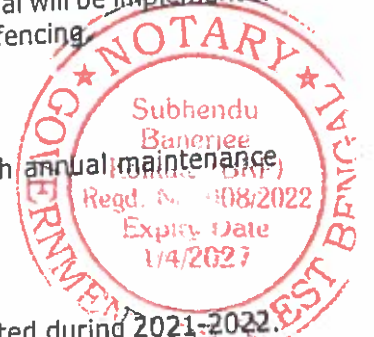
A scheme of fencing for 280 m along both banks of Circular Canal near Gallif Street (65 m of Gallif Street on left bank & 215 m of P. K. Mukherjee Road on right bank) at a cost of Rs. 27.56 lakh has been prepared and is, at present, under appraisal at the I & W Department for accordance of Administrative Approval & Financial Sanction. The fencing work has been proposed on the open spaces in between some public and private properties like KMC pump house, Pay & Use toilets, KMC building, KMC garden, building of Ramkrishna Mission etc. However, it is to mention here that there are considerable encroachments within the entire stretch of Circular Canal from Chitpur Bridge to B.T. Road Bridge not only on the above stated open spaces of the bank but also on the slope and sometimes even extending on the bed of the canal. Unless the said encroachments are removed piecemeal fencing will not give desired result. The bridges i.e. Chitpur Bridge, B. T. Road Bridge & R. G. Kar Road Bridge over Circular Canal do not belong to the I & W Department. Beautification work along both banks of Circular Canal will be implemented on the encroachment free available spaces on the canal side of proposed fencing.

2. (a) E

Floating materials from the Canal are being cleaned regularly through annual maintenance contract.

3. (a) F

Dredging of Circular Canal for the entire length of 1.20 km was completed during 2021-2022. At present no dredging is required at this stretch. However, dredging of Beliaghata Khal from Chingrighata to Gajnavi Bridge is ongoing, which will help in improving drainage through Circular Canal.



4. (a) G

As pointed out already under Sl. No. (1) above it is reiterated that a scheme of fencing for 280 m along both banks of Circular Canal near Gallif Street (65 m of Gallif Street on left bank & 215 m of P. K. Mukherjee Road on right bank) at a cost of Rs. 27.56 lakh has been prepared and is, at present, under appraisal at the I & W Department for accordance of Administrative Approval & Financial Sanction. Another scheme of fencing for 655 m amounting to Rs. 64.28 lakh along both banks of Circular Canal beyond B.T. Road Bridge up to R.G. Kar Road Bridge (280 m of Canal West Road on left bank & 375 m of M. N. Ganguly Road on right bank) has also been prepared and is under examination at Irrigation & Waterways Directorate. Here it may also be mentioned that the fencing work has been proposed on the open spaces in between some public utilities like KMC valve station, Pay & Use toilets etc. However, it is to mention here that there are considerable encroachments within the entire stretch of Circular Canal from B.T. Road Bridge to R.G. Kar Road Bridge not only on the above stated open spaces of the bank but also on the slope and sometimes even extending on the bed of the canal. Unless the said encroachments are removed piecemeal fencing will not give derived result.

5. (a) H

Authority of KMC has been requested on 30.10.2024 to conduct a joint survey to identify the drain-outfalls on both banks of the affected stretch of Circular Canal and land-pocket(s) at nearby locations with regard to implementation of rehabilitation etc.

6. (a) I

Pictorial overview of the affected stretch of Circular Canal has been prepared and appended herewith.

7. (b) B

I & W Department will explore the availability of surplus land for the purpose of installation of suitable waste water, sewage treatment facilities, once the locations of such waste water and sewage treatment plants are finalized by KMC.

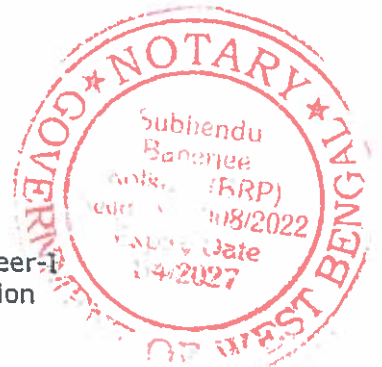
