, presently posted as a Sr. Divisional Commercial
Manager, Eastern Railway, Howrah Division, Howrah,
do hereby solemnly affirm and declare as follows:-



1. That as per paragraph 4 & 5 of the order dated 09.09.2024 "In this affidavit, it is stated that a proposal for pollution control related works at Dankuni Goods Shed has already been sanctioned by the appropriate authority and tentative date for completion for Notice for Inviting Tender (NIT) is fixed on 15.09.2024. However, along with this affidavit, the scheme of implementation of the Recommendations 5.2 in the letter of the Railway Board or the 2 directions of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board in its order dated 23.12.2022 which is part of the Original Application has not been filed.

The Respondent No.4, is, therefore, directed to place before this Tribunal the scheme and Action Plan for implementation of the directions of the West Bengal Pollution Control Board as well as the recommendations of the Railway Board.

2. For the compliance of the above said order it is humbly submitted that making provision of the said facilities as per WBPCB the earlier tender was cancelled due to some technical flaw. Fresh tender had already been invited and was opened on 18.10.2024.



Presently, Letter of Acceptance (LOA) of DKAE-pollution control related works at Dankuni Goods Shed under Sr.DEN/2/HWH has been issued on 14.11.2024 in favour of M/s SK SORAB-BURDWAN. According to the terms and conditions specified within the LOA, the completion timeline for the entire project is stipulated to be within 12 months from the date of acceptance.

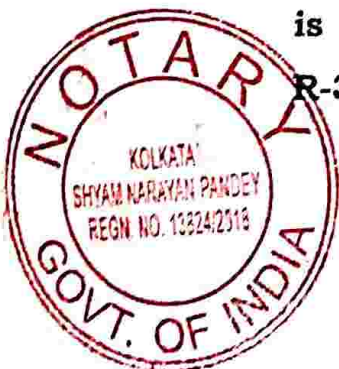

3. Further it is humbly submitted that procurement of automatic censor based ambient air quality monitoring station along with a display board and sound monitoring system has been sanctioned, procurement is under process. Requisition has already been generated on 04.10.2024 for procurement through GeM tender.

4. It is also humbly submitted that transport workers were not railway staff and are deployed by the Labour Association on day to day basis as per their requirement. Railway Authority is not liable to conduct regular health check of these labourers, drivers and helpers deployed by a third-party agency.
5. It is also further submitted that as per meeting held on 24.08.2023 in the office of the WBPCB at Parivesh Bhaban between Railway Authorities and officials of WBPCB, it was decided that Railway is exempted from the deposition of Bank Guarantee and as such the same has not been taken up. After the meeting held on 24.08.2023, no further letter for deposition bank guarantee was issued from WBPCB. However, DRM/Howrah has sent an acknowledgement letter on 29.08.2023.

A copy of the said letter dated 29.08.2023 is attached herewith and Marked as Annexure - R-4.

In view of what has been stated hereinbefore, It is respectfully submitted that the application may kindly be disposed with orders/ directions as deemed fit and proper in the facts and

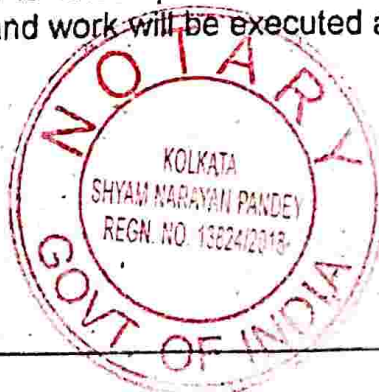
Furthermore, you have been kind enough to accord consent to exempt deposition of Bank Guarantee keeping in view that Eastern Railway is a Central Government Entity.
