REPORT SUBMITTED BY JOINT INSPECTION ON REPRESENTATION OF RESIDENTS OF N.T.R NAGAR, LAMBADI HAKKULA PORATA SAMITHI SATHUPALLI.

As per the instruction of the Joint Collector, Khammam we have proceeded to N.T.R Nagar, Sathupalli in connection with Representation filed by Sri Banoth Nandu Naik representative of Nagara Bheri Lambadi Hakkula Porata Samithi-Khammam and they informed that M/s SCCL is conducting blasting operations in JVR OC near to N.T.R Colony, due to which the slabs and walls of the houses in the colony were getting cracks and damaged walls and roofs. Finally they requested the District Collector to sanction the funds for repair the damaged houses. In this connection the following officials have conducted Joint inspection and enquiry on 19.06.2019.

During the enquiry the petitioner Sri Nandu Naik, some villagers of N.T.R. Nagar colony and Deputy Manager of SCCL have attended the enquiry. At the time the petitioner has shown some of the damaged houses to the inspection team.

During the visit to the houses the team found that there are some damages in roof ceiling and cracks in the walls. Further the petitioner has informed that the houses were constructed during 1987-1988 and the team also visited one(1) newly constructed house (2-3 years back) and it is found cracks in the walls. Further the villagers informed that during blasting operations they are facing sound and dust pollution due to which, the residents are getting health problems.

The team also visited the project office SCCL in Sathupalli and enquired with Sri B.Srinivasa Chary, Supdt. Of Mines and also the team of officers (Safety Officer, Blasting Officer and Civil Engineer).

The SCCL officials have informed that, they are conducting blasting operations within the permissible limits only. As per the Directorate General Of Mines Safety, Dhanbad Norms. The SCCL also conducting Seismographic tests every day and they are finding the values within the limits. Further, informed that they established dust suppression system and on line system air quality monitoring as per the Telangana state Pollution Control Board Norms. Finally, the Superintendent of Mines has informed that, the houses are not being damaged due to blasting operations, as they are following the safety Norms. Further M/S SCCL has submitted the following documents.

2. Supplementary data on LCQNO: 2812 given by Sri. Ponguleti Sudhakar Reddy M.L.C regarding opencast mine in Khammam dist.

5. Analysis report of On- line monitoring for Environment at mine area.
6. Latest 3 months (march 2019 to june 2019) ground vibration monitoring data. etc


Further, Deputy Inspector of survey land records, Kalluru as informed that M/s SCCL are conducting quarry operations within the leased area.


In view of the above, the joint inspection team has concluded that, a team consisting of concerned departments of R&B, Directorate General Of Mines Safety and Tahasildar/sathupalli may be appointed to identify the damaged houses due to blasting of SCCL operations and also assess the cost of the repairs of houses at NTR Colony, Sathupalli.

As the subject matter pertains to the department of mines safety, Govt. of India and the competent authority is the Dy. Director Of Mines Safety, Hyderabad and the issue involves the damages of houses, hence the competent authority is R&B for assessing the cost of damages and the concerned Tahasildar is also competent authority, as the area falls in his jurisdiction.
