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**ADDITIONAL SUBMISSIONS ON BEHALF OF RESPONDENT NO. 3, 4  
& 6 IN COMPLIANCE OF ORDER DATED 03.10.2024**


1. The present Additional Submissions are being filed on behalf of the State of Rajasthan through Chief Secretary i.e., Respondent No. 3, Water Resources Department i.e., Respondent No. 4, and Rajasthan River Basin & Water Resources Planning Authority, i.e., Respondent No. 6 to the Original Application in compliance of Order dated 03.10.2024.
2. The Answering Respondents have filed their reply to the Original Application on 02.10.2024 which has been taken on record.
3. Further, on the last date of hearing i.e., 03.10.2024, this Hon'ble Tribunal has directed the Answering Respondent to file details of the Kasawati River from its origin to its ultimate confluence (*hereinafter referred to as 'River'*) along with its map.
4. It is pertinent to highlight that Kasawati river is a seasonal river. This river historically has been considered a tributary to Sahibi River. The total catchment area of Krishnawati River is 288 Sq. Kms.

5. It is respectfully humbly submitted that the Krishnawati River, also known as Kasawati River, originates as 'Gair Mumkin Nalla' wherein small rivulets/water sources from villages including Neemod, Bageshwar, Baleshwar, Dokan and Nanagwas village, Rajasthan, forms the river and then it flows towards Raipur Patan Dam where it merges as a Delta in the Dam. It is pertinent to highlight that the above-mentioned river from Raipur Patan Dam, Neem ka Thana is known as Kasawati River. Further, the river terminates at Sirsa ki Dhani village within the State of Rajasthan. Thereafter, the river enters State of Haryana and continues to flow bypassing Bhedanti village and culminates at Nuni-Saluni village in Mahendragarh district, Haryana. Additionally, it is submitted that the distance covered by the river in the State of Rajasthan is 22 Kms whereas in the State of Haryana, it is 39.20 Kms. It is further brought to kind notice of this Hon'ble Tribunal that the river encounters various thick sedimentary deposits in its passage which leads to the disappearance of the river at few sites. A True Copy of Map showing origination and termination points of Kasawati/Krishnawati River is annexed herewith and marked as **Annexure AS/1**.
