Sir,

With reference to the above-cited subject, I am directed to offer following comments on the OA No. 555/2024 for the U.T. of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu are as follow:

The details of Forest cover based on the available Indian State of Forest Report of FSI from the year 2001-21 for the U.T. of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu is mentioned below:

In view of the above it has been seen that there is an increase of 0.10 sq. km. as compared to the ISFR 2019 of Forest Cover in the U.T. of DNH & DD. Further, the reason behind this negative change in the previous years are due to the following reasons:

1. The diversion of Forest Land for various Development Projects including of roads upgradation/widening across Union Territory of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu. The total diverted Forest Land from 2001 to 2021 is Approx.. 107 Ha.
2. The Individual rights given to the FRA claimant under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006.

Further, the Forest Department has taken various steps towards increasing the Forest Cover in the Union Territory by carrying out various Afforestation activities. The Plantation carried out by the Department from the year 2001 to 2021 is as follows:
