




We, Mukesh Kumar S/o. Bhagat Ram, Kiran Sharma W/o. Mukesh Kumar and Jatin Sharma S/o. Mukesh Kumar All R/o. Khasra No. 30/1/2, Modal Dodan, Khola Patwar Circle, Kandi, Tehsil Palampur, District Kangra, Himanchal Pradesh-176061, do hereby solemnly declares and affirms as under:

Preliminary Objections:

1. That the press release dated 28/07/2023 which is the basis of the present matter and released in the news paper Tribune is without verification of the correct facts by the Editor.
2. That in the press release dated 28/07/2023 while publishing a photograph, it is stated that some construction activities are going near Saurav Van Vihar, per contra the fact of the matter is that the land in question for which the present notice is issued to the deponents is a Private Piece of Land and has nothing to do with the land of Saurav Van Vihar or any construction activities.



3. That the Hon'ble Tribunal has thus taken cognizance of the Press Release of the "Tribune News Paper" but the facts on the ground level are altogether contrary from the Press Release.
4. That the deponents who are residents of the Palampur, Himanchal Pradesh in no manner have undertaken any activity which causes hazard to the environment or is against the conservation of forests and other natural resources and in respect of any matter incidental thereto.
5. That the Joint Committee Report filed by the Dy. Conservator of Forest, Palampur, Forest Division, Assistant Environmental Engineer, HP State Pollution Control Board and Collector, Sub-Division Palampur, Distt. Kangra, HP, which was served on the deponent also clearly indicates that the deponents are the owner of land bearing Khasra No. 30/1/1, 30/1/2 and 30/2 measuring 02-14-72 hectares in Mohal Dodan Khla Patwar Circle Khandi Tehsil Palampur and in order to protect their land have constructed a boundary wall, which is a private land.
6. That the Joint Committee Report filed by the Dy. Conservator of Forest, Palampur, Forest Division, Assistant Environmental Engineer, HP State Pollution Control Board and Collector, Sub-Division Palampur, Distt. Kangra, HP, also indicates that there is no act which is done by the deponents contrary to law or than any loss is caused to the Environment. Per contra the report suggest that the Press Release thus states about "Saurav Van Vihar" and the same is at a distance of 500 Meters from the private property of the deponents.




Facts of the Matter:

7. That the deponents are owner and in possession of the Khasra No. 30/1/1, 30/1/2 and 30/2 of Mohal Khola Patwar Circle Kandi Tehsil Palampur

Distt. Kangra, Himachal Pradesh. It is further submitted that the said land is about 02-14-72 Hts. (About 56 Karnal).

8. That the nature of the whole land is Khadetar: which means only Grass is grown in the field which is natural grass and no cultivation on the land is done. The deponents are in exclusive possession of the land and an old boundary wall of stones was existing since time immemorial so that the livestock / cattle could roam in a restricted space. This land is about 500 meters away from the Saurabh Van Vihar which is run and managed by HP Forest Department. The deponents private land was covered with a boundary wall of stones since decades back for the free roaming of cattle in the restricted area.


9. That due to vigorous monsoon from 7th till 10th July 2023 there was widespread rainfall of very heavy to extremely heavy rainfall in most parts of State especially in Palampur. Prior to the said rainfall a Press Release was also issued by the Govt Of India, Ministry of Earth Sciences India Metrological Department, Metrological Center, Shimla (H.P.) indicating Extremely Heavy Rain Fall between 07/07/2023 till 11/07/2023



That the state of Himachal saw 436% excess rains from July 7 till July 11 of 2023 and same led to Flash Floods and wide destruction in the State of Himanchal Pradesh. This was one of the maximum rain fall which the state received in last 100 Years. **Press Release By Govt Of India, Ministry of Earth Sciences India Metrological Department, Metrological Center, Shimla (H.P.) of Extremely Heavy Rain Fall between 07/07/2023 till 11/07/2023 and other Newspaper Articles of the same period are annexed herewith as Annexure R-1.**


11. Even in the private piece of land the deponents had given a right to way to the other villagers.

12. That the entire piece of land was private land and the Government of H.P. had no role to play in the maintenance of the same. This piece of private land is situated at a distance of approximately half kilometres from the place called Saurav Van Vihar.
13. That the extremely heavy rainfall from 07th till 11th July 2023 caused huge loss and after the rainfall stopped the boundary wall (constructed of stones and was in existence since decades) and the private road was found to be extensively damaged. The deponents got the boundary wall and the road repaired so that loss in future could be curtailed down in the event of heavy rain falls and the villages could still commute at any time.
14. That the road was repaired as an act for the community and the boundary wall was raised to protect the road for the Villages in case if Heavy Rain Fall takes place in future and to protect the piece of land from any encroachment by any third party.
15. That the press release on account of which the Hon'ble Tribunal never showed the actual photographs of the Site post heavy rain fall on 15/07/2023, when no road even left and the boundary of the land was extensively damaged / washed by the flash of unprecedented heavy rain, but gave a press release without any basis and the correct facts at the root level.
16. That the deponents restructured the boundary wall in their own piece of land and hence no permission was required from any authority. There was no construction which was going at the Site and the photograph in the Press Release is just manipulation of the correct and true facts.



Para Wise Reply to the Report of the Joint Committee:


- A. The contents of Para No. A of the Report of the Joint Committee are admitted.
- B. The contents of Para No. B of the Report of the Joint Committee are admitted. The report in itself indicates that the Nature of Land is "Khatedar" as per the revenue records and is neither a Forest Area nor Forest Land regarding residential / non residential classification in Non TCP/ Planning area as there are no rules currently in State to govern such land use. The deponents are the owner of the piece of land and further have not undertaken any activity which is detrimental to the interest of the environment or has caused pollution of any nature.
- C. The contents of Para No. C of the Report of the Joint Committee are admitted. The report clearly indicates that only surrounding walls were being reconstructed and that do within their premises. No other construction activity was ever carried out and after the report was called pursuant to the orders of the Hon'ble Tribunal, the deponents have already explained to the authorities that no construction activity is or was ever going on and the same will done even in future with due permission. Thus it was not in the knowledge of the deponents but the report also indicates that the Area does not fall in any Planning/ Special Area and provisions of H.P. Town and Country Planning Act, 1977.
- D. The contents of Para No. D of the Report of the Joint Committee is partly admitted and partly in incorrect. The road which is for Common Villages and is a part of private piece of land was not damaged due to boundary wall reconstruction but due to the heavy rain fall and the deponents got the same reconstructed. The four Chir Pine Trees have



also fallen due to heavy rains and the same were removed. Even no permission for three Chir Pine Trees is also required under law.

E. The contents of Para No. E of the Report of the Joint Committee is partly admitted and partly in incorrect. The road which is for Common Villages and is a part of private piece of land was not damaged due to boundary wall reconstruction but due to the heavy rain fall and the deponents got the same reconstructed.

F. In reply to the contents of Para No. F it is submitted that admittedly notice Under Section 133 Cr.P.C was issued and after the said notice the deponents explained the entire subject to the concerned SDM. The concerned SDM conducted a local inquiry and came to the conclusion that no public path was obstructed. The path was a private piece of land and the same was got repaired by the deponents after the same was damaged due to heavy rain. It is reiterated that the reason for damage was heavy rainfall and no other reason. The villages are quiet happy with the repair as the road is on private land and the Government does not undertakes repair work in private piece of land. Except the boundary wall and the road on private land which got damaged/ partly washed away due to heavy rain fall were repaired, no other activity took place and the same was required in the interest to protect the private piece of land also for the convenience of the other villagers.



17. That the deponents seek liberty to make additional submission and place additional documents is so required for the effective disposal of the present matter.

18. That the deponents who belongs to a small Village in Himanchal Pradesh have suffered due to the wrong press release without due and proper verification of the facts.

19. That in view of the aforesaid facts it is requested that the present proceedings may kindly be closed and the deponents be kindly discharged.



Unprecedented Rainfall in Himachal Pradesh for the period 07.07.2023-11.07.2023
Brief Write up

Rainfall Status during 7th to 11th July 2023 : Active to vigorous monsoon conditions prevailed in Himachal Pradesh during 7th to 10th July 2023 with widespread rainfall of very heavy to extremely heavy rainfall in most parts of State during this period. State received **734.4 mm** of rainfall as long period average during monsoon season (June-September) period 1971-2020. Out of total average rainfall of 734.4 mm state received 223 mm of rainfall against its normal rainfall of 41.6 mm only in 4 days viz 7th to 11th July 2023 with deviation of 436 % which is unprecedented as per records. All district of state have received large excess rainfall with highest rainfall in district kinnuar, kullu, solan. District Kinnaur and Lahal Spiti have received 43 % and 33 % of total average rainfall during these four days which is all time high. District wise cumulative rainfall during 7th to 11th July are given in table below. Unprecedented rainfall occurred during these days resulted in widespread damage to public and private properties viz overflowing of major rivers, blockage of roads, landslides, flashfloods, damage to bridges, complete disruptions of electrical and communication system, including loss of human lives. Damage as received from govt of HP is attached at the end of this report.

PERIOD : 07.07.2023 - 11.07.2023





Press Release for wet spell for the State of Himachal Pradesh

Weather Forecast for Himachal Pradesh for next five days valid till 0830IST of 10th July 2023.

- Light to moderate precipitation associated with thunderstorm/lightning is likely to continue in most parts of the State for subsequent 4 to 5 days. The Ongoing rainfall activities likely to be associated with spells of heavy to very heavy rainfall in low and mid hill districts of HP during this period. A fresh Western Disturbance is likely to affect Western Himalayan Region including Himachal Pradesh from the night of 8th July, 2023 and under its influence precipitation activity is likely to get intensified with possibility of heavy to very heavy rainfall in the districts of Chamba, Kangra, Shimla, Kullu, Mandi, Solan and Sirmour at isolated places on 09th July, 2023. Possibility of light snowfall activity at very higher reaches of the districts of Chamba, Lahaul-Spiti, Kinnaur, Kangra, and Kullu during this period.
- Aforesaid Spell is also likely to accompany with thunderstorm/lightning in low and mid hill/district.
- The average Maximum temperatures are likely to be 2 to 4 degree below normal for next 4 to 5 days.
- The average Minimum temperatures are likely to be normal for next 4 to 5 days.

Impact and Advisory

- In view of expected rainfall there could be disruption of traffic and other essential services in hilly district of state.
- Flashfloods along watershed and other channels in district of Shimla, Mandi, Kullu, Shimla, Sirmour, Solan
- Disruption of power and communication facilities in low and mid hill district of state in view of expected thunderstorm/lightning.
- Localized flooding of roads
- Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall.
- Avoid going in open areas in view of expected thunderstorms.
- Poor visibility conditions in hilly district of state creating difficulty to commute.
- Follow the advisories and guidelines issued by the concerned departments.
- Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination.
- Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard.
- Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often.
- Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.



This resulted in overflowing rivers, creeks and drains that have massively damaged infrastructure and disrupted essential services in Jammu and Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Punjab.

Action Suggested during thunderstorms & Lightning:

1. DO NOT take shelter under isolated trees.
2. Immediately get out of and away from ponds, lakes, and outdoor watery area (e.g. paddy transplanted).
3. Go indoors or seek safe pukka shelters after hearing thunder. Stay indoors for 30 minutes after hearing the last clap of thunder.
4. If no shelter is available, immediately get into the lightning crouch (a ball-like position with your head tucked and hands over your ears so that you are down low with minimal contact with the ground).
5. During travel, stay inside car or bus or train when thunderstorm occurs.
6. Do not use electric/ electronic appliance

gushed through villages, towns and fields – from the desert state of Rajasthan to the hills of Himachal Pradesh.

State governments stepped up relief and rescue efforts in the affected districts, navigating the trail of destruction left behind by the incessant downpour of the last three days.

Four of the latest fatalities were reported in Uttarakhand and the rest in Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Punjab. This is in addition to the 37 deaths reported till Monday.

In Himachal Pradesh, which is among the worst hit and where at least 300 are stranded, the meteorological department warned of the possibility of moderate to high flash floods in Shimla, Sirmaur and Kinnaur districts.

Northwest India saw incessant rainfall during the last three days, with many areas in Jammu and Kashmir, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan recording “heavy to extremely heavy” precipitation.

This resulted in overflowing rivers, creeks and drains that have massively damaged infrastructure and disrupted essential services in Jammu and Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Punjab.

In Uttarakhand, four pilgrims from Madhya Pradesh died and seven more were injured when a landslide triggered by heavy rainfall buried three vehicles near the Gangnani bridge on the Gangotri National Highway in Uttarkashi district on Monday night.

Three of the four bodies have been recovered and efforts are underway to pull out the fourth from the rubble, an official said, adding that two of the seven people injured are in serious condition.

Floods in the Jummagad river in Chamoli district on Monday night washed away a bridge built on it, blocking the Indo-Tibetan border road and snapping contact with over a dozen border villages. The bridge was located near Jumma village on the Joshimath-Niti highway, about 45 km from Joshimath. - PTI

Bad weather conditions hampers airlifting of tourists from Chandertal

A chopper sent to Chandertal in Lahaul and Spiti district of Himachal Pradesh to evacuate stranded tourists had to return due to bad weather conditions, officiating Director General of Police Satwant Atwal said.

"Will try again as the cloud cover gives way," she said in a tweet.

The first evacuation sortie took off around 12 noon from Bhuntar but had to return due to bad weather and a thick cloud cover.

Ms. Atwal appealed to those stranded to stay positive and said all-out efforts are being made rescue them.

"We are reaching out to you. All the government agencies are working hard to

Kunzum Top and is just eight kilometres away from the lake, Principal Secretary, Revenue, Onkar Chand Sharma said.

Around 300 people, mostly tourists, are stuck in camps at Chandertal, located at an altitude of 14,100 feet, following rain and snowfall in the region.

“Two of them were facing breathing issues due to the high altitude and they would be airlifted,” Mr. Sharma said.

According to officials, about 800 people are still stranded at Chandertal and Pagal Nallah in Lahaul and different parts of Mandi. - PTI

Key highways in Punjab, Haryana temporarily closed for traffic due to waterlogging

Key highways, including the Ambala-Ludhiana national highway, were temporarily closed for vehicular traffic on Tuesday due to waterlogging following heavy rainfall in Haryana and Punjab, officials said.

Ambala Deputy Commissioner Shaleen said the decision to temporarily close the highway was taken as a stretch of the road was inundated.

Other key highways — Ambala-Chandigarh and Ambala-Hisar — have also been temporarily closed for vehicular traffic since Monday evening. Officials said water, coming through agricultural fields, was flowing on the main carriageway.

Normal vehicular movement was also adversely affected on some other highways, including state highways, in many districts of the twin States. - PTI
