
1. That the Respondent No. 1, Delhi Development Authority (DDA), had filed a short affidavit dated 20.05.2025. The DDA claims "considerable improvement" in the condition of Kitchener Lake. It is submitted that these claims are entirely confined to the pages of the affidavit and do not reflect the ground reality.
2. That the DDA asserts it has been making "continuous and concerted efforts" toward rejuvenation, citing various tenders for bioremediation and cleaning. However, for the last several years, these efforts have remained procedural facades designed to befool this Hon'ble Tribunal. While the DDA points to a tender awarded as far back as 06.08.2024, the actual state of the lake continues to be neglected. The photographs evidencing the same is herein below:











3. That the photographs filed by DDA are untrue of the current ground situation. In contrast, the photographs captured on 15.02.2026 clearly shows dying lake with algae bloom and neglected area that contradicts the DDA's claims of a revived water body.
