
**Interim Report on Kolleru lake in the matter of O. A. No. 259 / 2020 (SZ) with O. A. No. 02 / 2021 (SZ) in compliance with the Hon'ble NGT, Chennai orders dated 24.03.2023 & 05.02.2024, 02.04.2025, 03.07.2024, 05.11.2024, 30.01.2025 and 05.03.2025.**

APPCB issued Notification of Award to M/s. NEERI during November, 2022 for carrying out Comprehensive study on Kolleru Lake as per directions of Hon'ble NGT. Accordingly, APPCB submitted the interim reports furnished by NEERI to Hon'ble NGT from time to time.

In this regard, M/s. NEERI submitted the draft Comprehensive study report on Kolleru Lake to APPCB in the month of February, 2024, and has been reviewed by the concerned APPCB officials assigned for dealing the matter of O. A. No. 259 / 2020 (SZ). Subsequently, M/s. NEERI made a power point presentation to APPCB, wherein, the officials represented during the meeting offered their remarks and suggestions on draft report. The draft report has been circulated to all the Stakeholder departments inviting suggestions/ comments for incorporation in the final report.

In this context, APPCB is awaiting comments on the draft report from the concerned stakeholder departments for inclusion in the final report and will be furnished to the Hon'ble NGT by 31.07.2025. The findings & recommendations made by CSIR-NEERI in the draft study report are herewith enclosed for kind perusal.

**COMPREHENSIVE SCIENTIFIC STUDY TO SAVE KOLLERU WILDLIFE SANCTUARY AND WETLAND OF KOLLERU BY CSIR-NEERI- STUDY FINDINGS AND SUGGESTED MANAGEMENT PLAN FURNISHED IN THE DRAFT REPORT;**

CSIR-NEERI, based on the study, offered the following remarks on the findings and suggested a management plan for conservation and restoration of Kolleru lake as detailed below:

**Findings:**

- Excessive pollutants (Industrial effluents, domestic waste, agricultural runoff etc.) are dumped into wetlands beyond the recycling capacity.
- Habitat destruction and deforestation create ecological imbalance by altering the population of wetland species.
- Conversion of wetlands for agriculture and encroachment by public.
- Overfishing and fish farming (aquaculture).
- Overgrazing in marshy soils.

**Management Plan:**

1. Habitat Restoration and Protection Initiatives:

- Implement habitat improvement measures such as restoration of the Kolleru Pelicanry.
- Enforce strict measures against bird poaching and manage invasive species effectively.
- Establish a riparian buffer zone around the lake to reduce human interference and protect the riparian zone from further degradation.

2. Research and Monitoring Programs:

- Conduct long-term avifaunal studies, bird migration tracking, and disease monitoring to gather data essential for informed conservation decisions.
- Regularly monitor the ecological impact of various anthropogenic activities on the lake's biodiversity and water quality.

3. Sustainable Resource Management:

- Promote the use of water hyacinth for sustainable products, enhancing the economic value of this invasive species.
- Develop sustainable fisheries through strategies such as aquaculture effluent treatment, improved harvesting infrastructure, and strengthening fish cooperative societies.

4. Catchment Area Rehabilitation:

- Address deforestation, agricultural runoff, and industrial discharges through afforestation, sustainable agricultural practices, and better waste management strategies.
- Initiate programs to prevent soil erosion, promote biodiversity, and ensure a healthier balance between agriculture and environmental conservation.

- Engage local communities through awareness programs and educational initiatives, fostering a sense of responsibility and ownership.
- Develop ecotourism opportunities, such as guided boat rides, nature trails, and educational facilities, to enhance public participation and support for conservation efforts.

**6. Infrastructure and Public Accessibility Improvements:**

- Enhance the infrastructure within Kolleru Wildlife Sanctuary, including the development of recreational facilities, boardwalks, and visitor education centers.
- Promote conservation awareness and visitor engagement through the creation of accessible green spaces and park areas.
