Sub: Status report in compliance of order dated 10/01/2020 passed by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi in O.A. No. 533/2019 titled Anubhav Kumar V/s Union of India & Ors.

Sir,

This is in reference to Hon'ble NGT's order dated 10.01.2020 and 23.06.2020 and letter dated 20.03.2020 to submit regular progress reports to CPCB. Pursuant to the aforesaid direction CRWC had already submitted its action plan on 10.02.2020 and its action taken and progress report on 19.04.2020 and 10.06.2020 respectively.

The matter was thereafter considered by Hon'ble NGT on 23.06.2020 in the light of the report filed on 22.06.2020 by CPCB notices, NGT issued certain recommendations for CRWC as under:

Recommendations issued to CRWC

1. CRWC may be directed to complete the remaining works within the timelines submitted in the revised progress report.
2. CRWC may be directed to ensure submission of revised action plan for education and protection of labour health by M/s GS Company within 01 week.
3. CRWC to ensure that the test of health workers involved in cement handling by M/s ACC Cement, M/s Wonder Cement, M/s Mangalam Cement and M/s Ambuja Cement be got conducted after the issue of Covid-19 pandemic is settled and report including the report of workers got tested by M/s GS Company be submitted to Labor Department, Delhi Government with plan of treatment of affected workers and for levy of compensation.

CRWC has immediately acted upon the directions issued by Hon'ble NGT order dated 23.06.2020 and completed all pending works within time frame. Below mentioned is the progress report/current

status as on 30.09.2020 in compliance of the directions issued to CRWC by Hon'ble NGT dated 10.01.2020.

- 1) **Northern Railway shall immediately construct a warehouse for handling of cement bags so as to minimize fugitive emissions until then no cement handling shall be permitted.**

This pertains to the Northern Railways and does not pertain to CRWC. However, it is informed that CRWC is already having covered warehouses at line no. 2 & 3 for minimize the fugitive emissions. It is also submitted that CRWC is not permitting any loading in the uncovered trucks and loading is allowed only in trucks which are properly covered with tarpaulin.

- 2) **Mechanical handling of cement bags using conveyor belts shall be introduced by NR and CRWC in order to reduce fugitive emission.**

i. For mechanical handling of cement bags, CRWC has made operational two tier-mounted conveyor belt machines with arms for handling/unloading of cement bags at its warehouse.

ii. In addition, CRWC has also designed a suitable conveyor belt system with folding arms with the help of one of the manufacturers of the machines, to make loading & unloading operations more effective. One machine purchased from M/s Vivian Conveyors, Pune, has been put in operation since 06.02.2020.

iii. CRWC is facing stiff resistance and protests from labourers/daily workers, as installation of conveyor machines is affecting their livelihood. The installation of conveyor belt machine has replaced and reduced the requirement of number of labourers working at the good shed. Installation of more machines will create more unrest amongst labourers/daily workers. Management is in process for convincing the labourers to use this machine.

iv. CRWC had invited tenders in the month of April, 2020 to purchase and install 10 more conveyor belt machines in the warehouse. However, the process for procurement got delayed due to the nationwide lockdown.

Current status: Along with earlier 3 conveyor machines put in operations since February, 2020, CRWC has also installed 10 new conveyor machines and the same have been put in operation w.e.f. August, 29, 2020.

The following relevant documents are enclosed at Annex - 1 for ready reference:-

- a) Photographs of the conveyor machines put in use.
- b) Invoice copy no. 095/2019-20 dated 20.01.2020 for Rs. 12,70,000/-
- c) Invoice copy no. 37/2020-21 dated 20.08.2020 for Rs. 24,65,787/- for 5 conveyor machines.
- d) Invoice copy no. 38/2020-21 dated 20.08.2020 for Rs. 24,65,787/- for 5 conveyor machines.

- 3) **The enclosures in the form of flexible belt curtain may be provided for the unloading sides.**

- (i) CRWC after considering various options available for flexible belt curtains placed an order on 07.02.2020 for supply/purchase and fixing of flexible PVC belt curtain. The work was in progress, as on March 2020 which was halted due to nationwide lockdown. The work has resumed and installation of flexible belt curtain was completed by this last week of June.

Current Status: CRWC has installed PVC strip curtains at all warehouse gates within time frame. All curtains have been put in use from June 28, 2020.

The following relevant documents are enclosed at Annex - 2 for ready reference:

- a) Photographs of the curtains installed at warehouse gates.
b) Copy of invoice no.13 dated 13.08.2020 is enclosed for supply and fixing of flexible PVT belt curtains.
- 4) **Warehouse cleaning shall be done with only mechanical means by NR and CRWC and it shall be done on regular basis. Cement collected shall be properly stored and records be maintained.**

- i. For cleaning the warehouse, four numbers of sweeping machines have been procured by service provider, M/s G. S. & Company and they are ensuring the proper mechanical ways of cleanliness since September, 2019 as cleaning of the warehouse being within their scope of work as per the agreement between CRWC and the service provider. The cleaning is now being done with the help of sweeping machines on regular basis.
- ii. The cement sweeping is being collected on regular basis and is being stored in respective compartments of the warehouse. The record for the same is being maintained in a separate register. The sweeping collected is handed over to cement companies by repacking in their cut and torn bags.

Current status: CRWC has ensured cleaning of warehouse and circulating area on regular basis through mechanical means. Records of sweeping dust collected are maintained in separate register. CRWC is regularly monitoring the process to ensure full compliance of the court/CPCB directions.

iii. The following relevant documents are enclosed at Annex - 3 for ready reference:-

- a) Copy of the invoice dated 17.09.2020 and 29.11.19 for the purchase of four machines by M/s G. S. & Company for sweeping of floors.
b) The photographs of the machines put to use for sweeping of floors.
c) Copy of the records being maintained for cement sweeping.

- 5) **Peripheral roads for vehicle movement should be paved and these should be properly maintained.**

i. The peripheral road for vehicle movement was already paved by CRWC and is being properly maintained. CRWC has purchased mini truck loaded road sweeping machine from M/s Pyara Singh & Co, Ludhiana. The peripheral road/circulating area is now being cleaned with the help of mini truck loaded road sweeping machine since February, 2020 purchased by CRWC.

ii. The following relevant documents are enclosed at Annex - 4 for ready reference:-

- a) Copy of invoice no.257 dated 08.02.2020 for the purchase of road sweeping machines.
- b) Photographs of the mini truck loaded road sweeping machines being put to use.

Current status: Peripheral road for vehicle movement has been properly maintained, cleaning for the same is done through truck loaded road sweeping machine.

6) **CRWC shall implement a systematic plan of action to educate and protect labourers engaged in the activity of cement sacks handling.**

i) M/s G. S. & Company the service provider, was instructed by CRWC vide its letter dated 16.01.2020 and 29.01.2020 to implement systematic plan of action to educate and protect labourers engaged in the activity of cement sacks handling.

ii) M/s G. S. & Company has submitted their systematic plan of action and conducted the labour education and protection programs on January 31, 2020; February 15, 2020; July 31, 2020, August 14, 2020 and September 15, 2020 wherein labourers were educated on various means and methods of protection from cement dust.

iii) Protection equipment's i.e. mask and gloves are also being given to the labourers on regular basis and they are being advised to use them all times during their stay in CRWC facilities.

iv) The following relevant documents are enclosed at Annex - 5 for ready reference:-

- a) Copy of the systematic plan of action of M/s G. S. & Company to protect labourers engaged by them.
- b) Reports for the programme conducted on July 31, 2020, August 14, 2020 and September, 2020 is enclosed. Report for January and February has already been submitted to CPCB.

Current status: CRWC has directed M/s. G.S. & Company to conduct labour education and protection programme at regular interval. The programme have been conducted on Jan 31,2020; Feb 15, 2020; July 31, 2020 August 14, 2020 and September, 2020.

CRWC has also asked M/s. G.S. & Company through letter dated 19.09.2020 to submit final action plan to protect and educate labourers engaged in cement siding by 30.09.2020 as per expert opinion shared by CPCB, letter dated 17.09.2020

7. All five cement companies (M/s ACC Cement, M/s Wonder Cement, M/s Mangalam Cement, M/s Ambuja Cement and M/s Ultratech Cement) shall implement a systematic plan of action to educate and protect workers engaged in the activity of cement sacks handling.

i. CRWC vide its letter dated 29.01.2020 has advised all its concerned cement user companies i.e. M/s ACC Cement, M/s Wonder Cement, M/s Mangalam Cement & M/s Ambuja Cement to implement systematic plan of action to educate and protect their workers engaged in the activity of cement sacks handling. M/s Ultratech are the user of Northern Railway siding only and they do not use CRWC godowns.

ii. The following relevant documents are enclosed at Annex - 6 for ready reference:-

a. Systematic Plan of action plan dated 16.03.2020, 21.02.2020; 25.02.2020 and 27.02.2020 submitted by M/s. Mangalam cement limited, ACC Cement Ltd., Wonder Cement Ltd and Ambuja Cement Ltd respectively are enclosed.

Current status: CRWC has directed all cement companies to ensure regular labour's education and protection program at regular interval. All cement companies are doing the same.

CRWC has also directed to all cement companies to submit the final plan of action to educate and protect labours engaged in cement handling as per expert opinion shared by CPCB, letter dated 17.09.2020

8. There should be a system of record keeping of workers engaged in the activity of cement handling. Periodic health assessment of workers should be done for workers engaged in cement handling and records shall be maintained.

i. CRWC has advised service provider M/s G. S. & Company and its users of the godown i.e. M/s ACC Cement, M/s Wonder Cement, M/s Mangalam Cement & M/s Ambuja Cement through letter dated: 16.01.2020 and 29.01.2020 for maintaining systematic record of workers engaged in the activities of cement handling by them and their periodic health assessment for which necessary records shall also be maintained.

ii. The following relevant documents are enclosed at Annex - 7 for ready reference:-

a) The list of 61 workers engaged by our service provider M/s G.S. & Company and their plan for periodic health assessment.

Current status: M/s. GS & Company has submitted their list of labours engaged at the siding. Cement companies deploy workers on ad-hoc basis whenever there is a requirement; no record is being maintained by them. For periodic health assessment, M/s. GS & Company and ACC Cement have got their workers consulted with doctors and test reports have been submitted on 21.08.2020 and 09.06.2020 respectively.

9. Test for remaining workers involved in loading and unloading activities shall be immediately got conducted through an environment health physician and all workers

detected with health impact shall be treated at the cost of M/s G S Company and Cement Companies, as applicable. CRWC and NR shall monitor compliance and submit report to DPCC and CPCB.

- i. The above has been advised to service provider M/s G.S. & Company and the respective cement user companies' i.e. They have been asked to get the tests done for the labourers engaged by them vide their letter dated 16.01.2020, 29.01.2020, 26.02.2020 and 27.02.2020.

Current Status: M/s. G S & Company has submitted the test reports of all 61 labours to CPCB on August 21, 2020. Cement companies will submit test reports of workers involved in cement handling after Covid-19 pandemic.

Cement companies will get the test done of their labourers post pandemic of COVID -19 as per Hon'ble order dated 23.06.2020.

CRWC being a responsible PSU, is fully committed towards its environmental obligations. It ensures that the effective and proper measures are in place to ensure no harm caused to the environment. It has already constructed fully covered warehouses with proper paved roads and with all amenities required for labours for operations at our terminals. CRWC premise is regularly cleaned through mechanical means. The complainant had also state that the pollution at the siding is not attributable to CRWC, rather it is due to the Railway's operations and open handling of cargo at Railways siding by customers. As a part of its commitment toward environment, CRWC, despite being an MSME, has already spent more than INR1.5 Cr to ensure proper and effective measures are in place to control fugitive dust emission at the Terminal and for protection of the air quality.

Thus, considering that CRWC is a small MSME with limited margin and the fact that it is already incurring huge expenditure to ensure proper cleanliness and protection of environment and safety of workers and staffs working there, the Board may please acknowledge the efforts made by CRWC.

Conducted by G. S. & Company at CRWC
Shakurbasti warehouse.

Date of Event: 14.08.2020

Report Summary

A labour health safety and education program on awareness and protection from cement dust was organized on 14th August 2020 at CRWC Shakurbasti terminal. A total of 102 labours were participated in the program. The program was jointly conducted by CRWC Ltd. and M/s G S & Company.

Labours were educated regarding the ill effects of the cement dust on human body, how to protect them from cement dust, how to protect their organs while working at cement warehouse. Labors were encouraged to use the PPE & to maintain personal hygiene by making them understand the importance of the same.

Briefs of the program conducted

Effects of Cement Dust on Human Body:

- Irritation in eyes, nose, throat & upper respiratory system.
- Skin irritation, thickening of skin, skin damage.
- Trace amounts of crystalline silica which is abrasive to the skin and can damage lungs
- Prolonged or repeated exposure can lead to a disabling and often fatal lung disease called silicosis.
- Hexavalent chromium can cause a respiratory allergy called occupational asthma. Symptoms include wheezing and difficulty breathing.

Controls

The following are some basic recommendations for handling and using cement safely.

Personal protection:

To protect skin from cement and cement mixtures, workers should wear:

- alkali-resistant gloves
- coveralls with long sleeves and full-length trousers (pull sleeves down over gloves and tuck pants inside boots and duct-tape at the top to keep mortar and concrete out)
- waterproof boots high enough to prevent concrete from flowing in when workers must stand in fresh concrete
- suitable respiratory protective equipment such as a P, N or R 95 respirator when cement dust can't be avoided
- Suitable eye protection where mixing, pouring, or other activities may endanger eyes (minimum—safety glasses with sideshields or goggles, under extremely dusty

conditions, tight-fitting unvented or indirectly vented goggles. Don't wear contact lenses when handling cement or cement products).

Hygiene:

- Clothing contaminated by wet cement should be quickly removed. Skin in contact with wet cement should be washed immediately with clean water.
- Don't wash your hands with water from buckets used for cleaning tools.
- Provide adequate hygiene facilities on site for workers to wash hands and face at the end of a job and before eating, drinking, smoking, or using the toilet. Facilities for cleaning boots and changing clothes should also be available.

Apart from this labours were educated regarding the prevention of spread of Corona virus and COVID 19 pandemic. Labours were encouraged to follow the preventive measure to avoid spread of corona virus like social distancing, wearing masks, regular hand wash, and use of sanitizer, avoid large gatherings, etc.

Personal protective equipments like masks and high quality reusable gloves are distributed to the labours. Labours were encouraged to use mask instead of cloth (gamcha) by making them understand that using mask is much more beneficial for them for their safety and protection from dust & corona virus. Total participation of labourers were 102.





First camp is planned on 3rd March 2020.
2. We will regularly ensure distribution and all time availability of safety PPEs - nose masks/hand gloves as per standard suggested by CRWC Management.
3. We will educate the labour about correct handling of cement bags, impact and safety precautions to be taken by them. This will be done on monthly basis, first is planned on 3rd March 2020.
4. All material will be loaded in tarpaulin covered trucks to avoid spread of dust in the environment.




