**REPLY TO THE ACTION TAKEN REPORT (ATR)  
DATED 05.08.2022 FROM KSPCB  
IN  
OA 312/2022  
(VILASINI RAMKUMAR AND OTHERS VS STATE OF KARNATAKA)**

1. **Claim :** The applicant Mrs. Vilasini Ramkumar did not attend.  
**Reply:** There was no intimation of the inspection to the petitioners. Petitioners were informed via phone call on the day of the inspection at 1130 am that too by the engineer who worked for the contractor working on the rejuvenation of the lake.
2. **Claim:** Shri Shailesh Charati and Advocate representing the petitioners were present during the inspection.  
**Reply:** The claim is false. The petitioners were intimidated and chased away by the crowd which had gathered there, and the petitioners had no knowledge of any inspection being done until this ATR was made available on the website of NGT. (Please refer to Annexure I - email sent to the hon'ble NGT on July 27, 2022, narrating the events on 07 July 2022)
3. **Claim:** The villager's claim that the burial ground is in this premises of the Kembattahalli lake for many years.  
**Reply:**
  - a. According to government revenue records there is no burial ground. (Annexure II(a)[kembattahalli],(b)[kottanuru] - copies of the village maps, annexure III - the revenue records from the lake survey done in 2015 are produced)
  - b. The whole area was fenced by the Bangalore Development Authority which was the custodian of the lake until 2020. The fence has been cut open at multiple places to make way for encroachments.
  - c. The claim that the burial ground is in the premises of the lake since many years is false as we produce satellite images (Google Earth) starting from November 2000 to 2022 which show the claimed burial ground area submerged under water. Satellite images from successive years show that the structures have come up from 2017 onwards (Annexure IV - satellite images of the lake starting from November 2000 to February 2022)
4. **Claim:** One Kum. Harini said that her father Sri. B.N.Sachidananda died recently and was buried in the same burial ground and the petitioners in this case have filed a police complaint on her in May 2022.

**Reply:** The claim is false and put to proof.

5. **Claim:** The BBMP officials have fenced with chain-link to the whole lake. They have locked the entry gate from the lake side and there is no approach road to the burial ground.

**Reply:**

- The BDA which was the custodian of the lake until 2020 has put a fence around the lake.
- The fence has been cut at multiple places to make road, burial ground etc. Many requests to the BBMP officials to stop the encroachment by closing the openings have gone unheeded. The entry to the burial ground was closed only after the Hon'ble NGT registered a case in this regard.
- So, it is clearly forthcoming that the BBMP officials in charge of the lake now and BDA officials in the past have failed to protect the lake. (Annexure V - emails to the officials to take actions to prevent encroachments, Annexure VI - newspaper coverage of the encroachments at the lake).
- It should also be noted that the BBMP as part of its lake rejuvenation effort has not made any effort to clear the encroachments.

6. **The extent of the lake and survey numbers as per the information available in public domain:**

- a. 8 Acres 7 Guntas (Source: BDA, Workshop on "Bring Back the Lakes" dated 13.06.2016, Appendix – VII)
- b. 7 Acres 20 Guntas (Source: Karnataka Lake Conservation and Development Authority(KLDCA) accessed at : <https://karunadu.karnataka.gov.in/ldakarnataka/Pages/List-of-lakes-in-BBMP-BDA-LDA-KFD-MI.aspx>, Appendix- VIII)
- c. Village maps of Kembattahalli and Kothanuru show three survey numbers - sy no 3 (Kembattahalli), sy no 32/3 (Kottanuru), sy. No 99 (Kembattahalli).

From the above points it is evident that the survey of the lake is incomplete and has many discrepancies.

**8. Claim:** Regarding Ecology of Kembattahalli Lake: There is no chance of entry of sewage into the Kembattahalli lake

**Reply:** This claim is false. There is currently sewage water entering into the lake via the entry point between the two Banyan trees. This is coming from the BDA layout on the burial ground side of the lake. We tried contacting BWSSB (Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board) on this but could not reach them.

## 9. SUMMARY

1. Encroachment of the lake at multiple places by government, private parties including a burial ground and the authorities have turned a blind eye towards this.
2. Construction activity in the buffer zone of the lake and BBMP has turned a blind eye. In some cases, it's allegedly the violator.
3. There are violations of the Storm Water Drain norms. Either Storm Water Drains are encroached, or buffer zone not maintained around the Storm Water drains as per norms.
4. The lake rejuvenation project has made the wastewater weir too low. In this torrential rain too, the lake is not even half full leading to less than 50% utilization of lake capacity.
5. Sewage water is still entering the lake via inlets.

## 10. Prayers

We humbly request that the Hon'ble NGT may be pleased to :

1. Pass an order to survey all the survey numbers of the lake as per the village maps (Kembattahalli and Kottanuru).
2. Pass an order to identify the encroachments, clear the same and recover the lake area.
3. Pass an order to direct the Government to provide alternate solutions to the displaced encroachers.
4. Pass an order to survey the buffer zone for illegal constructions, take actions to clear those constructions.
5. Pass an order to survey the Storm Water Drains, remove all encroachments, and maintain the Storm Water Drains according to the buffer zone norms.
6. Pass an order to stop the sewage water entry into the lake.
7. Pass an order to ensure that the full capacity of the lake is utilised for water storage.
8. Pass an order to seal off the lake except for the entrance gates.
9. Pass an order to establish a mechanism to monitor water quality of the lake at regular intervals.
10. Pass an order to direct the Government to provide for round the clock security with CCTV cameras.
11. Pass an order to direct the Government to fulfill and adhere to the buffer zone norms strictly.

12. Pass an order to initiate actions on the officials who have allowed encroachments / buffer zone constructions by acts of commission/omission.

Subject : Regarding the case 312/2022

Sir,

As you are aware the NGT has registered 312/2022 on 06/05/2022 regarding the Kembattahalli lake, JP Nagar 8th Phase , Bengaluru (Bengaluru South Taluk, Bengaluru Urban district). This was registered based on an e-mail complaint. The Hon'ble NGT ordered for the constitution of a joint committee with following members :

1. Commissioner, State Pollution Control Board (Chairman, Karnataka State Pollution Control Board aka BBMP)
2. Municipal Corporation Greater Bengaluru (Bruhat Bengaluru Municipal Corporation aka BBMP) ,
3. State Wetland Authority i.e. Karnataka Lake Conservation and Development Authority
4. Collector, Bengaluru i.e. District Commissioner, Bengaluru Urban

On Thursday July 7th, we received a call around 11:30 AM from an engineer who is working for the contractor developing the lake, that some officials including an IFS officer have come and they are asking for all parties to come to present their views. Many of us were in the midst of work and it's very difficult to attend without prior intimation. However, three of us decided to meet the committee. Two of us reached the meeting place first and the other person reached later.

We were shown into a school and there were two ladies officers and one gentleman representing the government. One of the lady officers was Mrs. Anita Arekal, IFS and the other officer was Joint Commissioner, BBMP, Bommanahalli we later learnt. We did not get to know the other woman officer's name. The room was already full of people possibly from the nearby village of Kembattahalli.

To say that the environment in the meeting room was hostile would be an understatement. We were continuously being asked in an intimidating tone what was the harm the locals had done that we had complained about the lake. We only said that we are not against anyone but for protecting the waterbody and will give representation to the committee. The people assembled were not keen to listen and were cross questioning us. We expressed our anguish at the environment and also asked the officials if intimidation was the intent of this meeting. The IFS officer tried to tell the people that the committee would listen to each and everyone and there is a need to maintain order.

The IFS officer asked us to present our grievances. One person among us mentioned the following issues concerning the lake :

1. no security to the lake - illegal openings in the fence
2. no surveillance
3. sewage water entering the lake
4. burial ground. We were mentioning the revenue records of the lake, burial ground , and satellite pictures for the last ~20 years. As soon as the topic of burial ground was raised, commotion started. Some people started shouting and some threatened us with physical violence. Some recorded the proceedings to some extent. At that moment we decided it

was futile and also not safe to remain there anymore and started coming out. We were not given way but then the Home guard intervened. When we got out one person came and told us that we should not come to the lake premises. Another guy followed us as we walked towards our vehicle and took pictures of the car. Mrs Anita Arekal took our phone numbers when we came out of the meeting.

So this was how the meeting with the committee went and obviously we could not present our side of the story as we were threatened. We are bringing this to the knowledge of the Hon'ble NGT that efforts to save a lake can mean dangers to the life and limbs of citizens who get involved. We have to now live with fear of attack on us. This is the sorry state of affairs in the city of Bengaluru. We request the Hon'ble NGT to enable us to submit our grievances to the committee electronically and also direct authorities to provide protection to us and our families.

As funds have already been sanctioned for the development of the lake, we request you to start the work. In the meanwhile we also request that any openings to the lake be fenced and patrolling be increased so that no illegal activities take place inside the lake boundary (already discussed with AEE)

As you know the tender for Kembattahalli lake improvements was floated on 30.01.2021 and as per information available to us work order was issued sometime in August 2021. However there has been almost no work done on the lake. We were earlier told that the work could not be taken up due to rains.

In the last week we observed some earth moving equipment operating inside the lake premises but it has again stopped. We have also come to know that there are certain quarters who are obstructing lake improvement work. It is learnt that there are demands for not clearing encroachments, constructing roads, playground, community hall etc

inside lake premises. This is outrageous especially after the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka. It is pertinent to note that the Hon'ble PM of India has stressed the need to conserve and develop water bodies on multiple occasions. So any such demands cannot be heeded to. The BBMP has the authority to deal with such obstructions via seeking police protection and other legal means.

So we urge that the lake work be carried out without any further delays and adequate measures be taken as per law to deal with obstructions.

Subject: Continuing encroachments of the Kembattahalli lake (burials) and BBMP's inaction to prevent and clear the encroachments

Sir/Madam,

As you might be aware, on Friday, 4th March 2022 around 1300 hours a burial took place inside the Kembattahalli lake premises. As soon as we got to know about people coming into the lake for burial we tried contacting 1. Smt Nitya J (AE Lakes). 2. Smt . Usharani (AE Lakes). 3. Home guard incharge Shivaraj 4. Police (Thalaghattapura police station). We could not talk to the BBMP Engineers as they did not receive the phone calls. The Home guard incharge said he would go immediately to the lake but we do not know if he ever reached. After multiple calls to the Police, the Police party visited the lake premises. We were informed by the inspector of Thalaghattapura Police station that people who had come for burial argued with the Police that the lake premises are burial grounds and they would continue to bury the dead there. The Police returned from the place after this i.e. without any action.

The lake premises are demarcated clearly by a fence and the records are very clear that there is no burial ground. We have gathered satellite pictures from Google Earth of the Kembattahalli lake starting from the year 2000 till 2019. The pictures clearly show that there was no burial ground at that place. Dishank application shows the fenced area as Lake/Tank.All the structures seem to have come in the last ~ 5 years or so. Notwithstanding the official status of the lake there are some people who are claiming that a part of the lake premises is a burial ground.

There have been multiple burials at the lake premises after the lake was handed over to the BBMP sometime at the start of 2020. Barring one instance when a wall was demolished, which was being built to demarcate the burial grounds from the lake premises, there has been no action to stop these burials which are nothing but systematic encroachment of lake premises. Needless to say there is no thought towards clearing the already encroached land. We are told it's the responsibility of the Revenue department.We believe as custodians of the lake it's the responsibility of BBMP to take actions to clear the encroachments. Unfortunately we are not seeing efforts from the BBMP to stop continuing encroachments and clear the existing encroachments. The fence is broken at multiple places and is easy for the miscreants to enter and carry out the burials. We have requested the Engineers in charge of the lake multiple times to close the openings and to secure the premises but, the same has not been acted upon.

The BBMP's failure to prevent encroachment of lake premises and failure to clear encroachments is nothing but a violation of the orders of the Government Of Karnataka regarding water bodies and also violation of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka.

We hope and urge that the BBMP wake up now and take actions towards protecting the lake premises. We request that the BBMP:

1. Register FIR for the burial that was done on Friday, 4th March 2022.

2. Seal all entry points by fixing the fence.
3. Station home guards at the premises to thwart any efforts to encroach the lake.
4. Take actions to remove the encroachments

Please initiate actions immediately.

**Subject: Continuing encroachments in the Kembattahalli lake and the inaction of the official machinery**

Sir/Madam,

The attempts to encroach continue unabated and in broad daylight.

On Sunday 20th March 2022 morning, some laborers were found within the premises of the lake getting ready to start some construction activity. We tried reaching the concerned AEE - Nitya J but could not. So we contacted the home guard incharge Shivaraj who arranged some guards to come over. The guards came and stopped the work and they were there for most of the time.

On Monday 21st March 2022 in the morning around 7AM, again laborers were seen in the lake premises to do some construction in the lake premises. The same set of actions were taken - called Nitya J, her phone not reachable. Then called the home guard incharge Shivaraj, who promised homeguards would be sent as soon as they arrive for their morning shift. Sensing that this may take more time, some of us called the Police (Talaghattapura station). The Hoysala came in sometime and the activity was stopped. As soon as the patrol vehicle left, the construction was promptly started. We again called the officials, the home guard. Homeguards arrived but there were now 20+ people gathered at the lake premises to confront anyone coming to stop the work. The homeguards reported that the Police were not answering their calls so, we again called the Police. The Police were not willing to come citing that they had already visited. After much persuasion they went to the site and started calling us. After some time at the premises Police and homeguards left the lake. The construction activity continued. The home guard incharge informed us that the Police needed us to come to the Police station to book a FIR. The behavior of the Police has been very strange during this incident. The land is government land with a fence all around (BDA) and the Police are witness to the encroachment attempts and in spite of this they need a FIR by the public ? They are duty bound to register a FIR and book the culprits. This clearly shows failure on their part and their inaction is aiding the encroachers. The BBMP Lake division officers are not to be seen and they have failed to prevent encroachments multiple times. They have not taken any action to secure the lake instead they have preferred to look the other way. By their inaction they are encouraging the people who want to grab land. The encroachment attempts seem to be well planned. The activities happen in early mornings, late evenings, on holidays i.e. when officers can easily claim they are not on duty. The Police do not arrive at the location or arrive late.

The concerned officers are not taking any preventive actions to stop these encroachments and this has been happening for the last ~2 years. The officers are not ready to seal the illegal entry points to the lake in spite of many requests.

We have been writing to the concerned officials and we have given representations on :

However, the officials have failed to take actions to prevent encroachments and also to ensure that the lake development continues without any hindarances (we have heard that any resistance to encroachment results in impediments to the lake development work which is underway).

We once again via this letter urge you to kindly :

1. Register FIR for the encroachment attempt on 20th and 22nd March 2022.
2. Seal all entry points by fixing the fence.
3. Station home guards at the premises to thwart any efforts to encroach the lake.
4. Take actions to remove the encroachments
5. Take actions to remove impediments to the lake development works.



## Two policemen caught with ganja near Chief Minister's residence

In a case of the fence eating the crop, two policemen who were deputed for security duty at the residence of Chief Minister Basavaraj Bommai in RT Nagar have been reportedly arrested on charges of drug peddling.

Both the policemen were attached to the Koramangala po-

lice station. Assuming that it would be a safe place to peddle drugs near the CM's residence, they were procuring ganja from two habitual drug peddlers.

The patrolling police caught the two constables red handed when they were trying to sell drugs on the 80 feet road in RT Nagar.

The two policemen were identified as Shiva Kumar and

Santosh. Both were deputed for providing security to the chief minister's house. It is said that the duo were peddling drugs for quite some time. When the policemen were subjected to questioning they confessed to have procured the ganja from Akhil Raj and Ahmjad Khan, the habitual drug peddlers.

"On Thursday the police control room received infor-



mation about the presence of a suspicious auto on 80ft road in RT Nagar police station limits. The Hoysala staff immediately reached the spot, detained four persons and seized the auto. All the four were brought to the police station of whom to were from Koramangala police station," said an officer on part of investigations. Of the two, one is a head constable while the other

is a police constable. During the search ganja was recovered from them. Both the policemen are charged under Section 20b of NDPS act. A case has been registered against them by the RT Nagar police.

Further investigation is underway. The police have seized their mobile phones and are analyzing their mode of operation.

#### Man held for stabbing sister

Baiyappanahalli police have arrested a person on charges of attempted murder. The accused has been identified as Sunil, 32. The police said that the accused stabbed his sister-in-law's husband, Rakesh, with a knife on January 14 around 10am when the latter was celebrating his birthday at his residence along with his family.

Rakesh was married to Sunil's sister-in-law last year. During the interrogation, the accused claimed that his in-laws gave more importance to Rakesh than him which infuriated him. It was also revealed that the accused often used to engage in an argument with Rakesh warning him not to visit the in-laws' house.

On the night of Rakesh's birthday, he invited his in-laws to his residence which made Sunil disappointed. Sunil called one of his friends and entered Rakesh's house and started abusing him. Both of them had a war of words which took a violent turn. The accused took out a knife from his pocket and stabbed Rakesh in his stomach before fleeing along with his friend, police said.

Rakesh was shifted to hospital immediately and survived the injury. Police have taken up a case against Sunil.

## So many hurdles to revive Kembathalli lake

While most of the lakes in the city are hungry for funds, Kembathalli Lake has been facing problems of a different kind when it comes to the much-delayed rejuvenation. One hurdle is the jurisdictional dispute between two wards – Anjanapura and Gottigere in Bengaluru South Assembly constituency.

The Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) Lakes Department had sanctioned Rs 3 crore for the rejuvenation of the lake a year ago but the rejuvenation work is yet to begin. The BBMP Lakes Department engineers are attributing this to the protest by some villagers. They said the residents of Kembathalli want to develop the lake land into civic amenities like a playground, burial ground and also construct

a community hall.

"It would be better for the villagers as well as those residing in the vicinity of the lake if the rejuvenation work begins. The villagers want to bury bodies on the lake land. They claim it is a burial ground. I want the BBMP authorities to maintain the status quo and not allow the burial of bodies in future. What is the use of burying bodies at a place

filled with dirty and stinking water?" asks Anand Yadwad, a lake activist.

According to Shailesh Charati, a resident of JP Nagar 8th phase, efforts are underway to rejuvenate Kembathalli Lake since 2019 and it was supported by the two corporators of Gottigere and Anjanapura wards and Bengaluru South MLA M Krishnappa. "The BBMP had floated the tender for the rejuvenation of the lake in January 2021 and the work order was issued sometime in August. Initially jungle clearing was taken up but it was stopped," said Shailesh Charati.

The lake activists and residents said that the lake land was encroached upon and a few people made an attempt to construct a temporary wall for the burial ground but the BBMP authorities demolished it. "Burial of dead bodies is taking place at

night. Now, villagers are creating hurdles to the lake rejuvenation work. Our only request is that the concerned officials and representatives work expeditiously to rejuvenate the lake without giving in to illegal demands," he said.

Manjula B, a resident of Royal County Layout, said the BBMP authorities have to take measures to save and protect Kembathalli Lake from encroachers. "I want the BBMP authorities to rejuvenate the lake as early as possible for the betterment of people residing in the vicinity," said Manjula.

Meanwhile, BBMP assistant executive engineer (Lakes) Nithya J said the rejuvenation of the lake has commenced. "As far as the encroachment of the lake land is concerned, there is a burial ground and a temple on the land. The revenue officials have to take a call on this issue," said the assistant executive engineer.

## Married woman, partner end lives

A 26-year-old married woman along with her 23-year-old live-in partner committed suicide in the Devanahalli area. The latter who was a bachelor was working as a taxi driver. It is said that both of them met just a month back and started living together in a rented house. They claimed to be husband and wife while taking the house on rent. The reason for the suicide is being ascertained.

The police have identified the deceased as Basavaraju, 23, and Jyothi, 26. Both are from Raichur and got to know each other at Kodigehalli in Bengaluru. Within a month of meeting each other, the two fell in love and moved to Deva-

nahalli. They committed suicide by hanging on Saturday.

Earlier, around six-years-back Jyothi got married to Ramu who is from Kalaburagi. The two came to Kodigehalli to make a living. They did not have children and Jyothi is said to have been upset about not becoming a mother. After she met Basavaraju, she left her husband and started to stay with the former. It is said that both families came to know about the live-in relationship between Jyothi and the taxi driver. After their relationship became public, the two are suspected to have committed suicide by hanging.

The Devanahalli police in the outskirts of the city has registered a case and are investigating.

## Girl who went missing traced after 78 days

The 17-year-old girl who was said to have been passionate about Shamanism and who went missing from her Rajajinagar residence, has been traced after nearly 78 days at an ashram in Gujarat's Surat. The Subramanyanagar police who had registered a complaint in this regard traced the girl and handed her back to her parents.

However in a strange twist to the case, the girl has told police she did not know how the Shamanism angle came up and claimed she left home following an argument with her parents for not enrolling her in the col-

lege of her choice as she was interested in pursuing her studies in fashion design. The girl has completed her 12th standard in the CBSE stream. The police who had formed teams to trace the girl had ruled out the possibility of kidnapping based on the CCTV footage. The victim had gone missing on October 31st and was traced on January 15. The girl has told police that she had taken Rs 2500 and two set of clothes while leaving the house. Her parents had taken to Twitter to seek help from the public to trace her. After she went missing, the police did a forensic analysis on her online activities and had found out that she was reading topics related to Shamanism.

## Workers at KCFS godowns stop work

Loading and unloading of food grains meant for transporting to fair price shops across the state has been affected since Monday. Around 3,000 workers engaged at 191 Karnataka Food and Civil Supplies (KCFS) godowns stopped loading and unloading of foodgrains in support of their long-pending demands.

"We are compelled to stop work as the authorities have failed to redress our grievances for more than three years. Many of us are finding it tough to make both ends meet with the meager amount we get for loading and unloading food grains at the KCFS godowns," said Ahmed, a member of Karnataka Food and Civil Supply Corporation Loading and Unloading Labours' Union.

There are 10 KCFS godowns across the



city and eight to 10 people work at each of these godowns. Each worker gets Rs 18 for loading two bags (50 kgs each) of rice or wheat and Rs 8 for unloading two bags. "We have been demanding that the rates be hiked from Rs 18 to Rs 25 for loading two bags. Our other demand is to increase wages for unloading two bags from Rs 8 to Rs 13 but our requests have gone in vain," he said, adding that he had joined as a worker 22 years ago and the wages were then Rs 1.49 for loading a bag of (one quintal) rice or wheat.

The other demands include issuing of wage slip, identity cards and paid holidays. "We also want the KCFS authorities to ensure that contractors pay PF and ESI contributions on time," said Nadeem Sab.

Meanwhile, Dr Shamla Iqbal, Commissioner of Food, Civil Supplies and Consumers Affairs Department has assured the agitating workers that their demands would be considered by the month end.

In a letter issued to the agitating workers, the Commissioner said that a meeting was scheduled to be held on January 7 but got postponed due to the Covid-19 pandemic. "I will take suitable action on your demands after consulting the government departments concerned," Dr Shamla Iqbal said in a letter.

## Home isolation: BBMP supplied 55,000 medical kits

Bengaluru, Jan. 18

To support people in home isolation, the Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike (BBMP) authorities have made arrangements to supply medical kits for those who tested positive at their doorsteps.

"We have already supplied 55,000 medical kits to those in home isolation. We have made arrangements to procure 90,000 medical kits that consist of basic medicines excluding antibiotics. There is no need for Covid patients to take antibiotics. As of now not many emergencies are reported and there is no shortage of medicines," said BBMP Chief Commissioner Gaurav Gupta.

The BBMP Chief Commissioner has advised the public not to depend on medical kits available at medical stores as these are not a substitute for the RT-PCR test. "My advice to those who use such equipment is to opt for the RT-PCR test which is being conducted at all BBMP primary health centers free of cost. As of now, we are conducting one lakh RT-PCR tests per day," he said.

Appealing to the public not to get panicky over the surge in the number of people tested positive for coronavirus, he said that the majority of people testing positive do not require hospitalization. "As of now, there are 1600 patients at private hospitals availing treatment for corona-

virus. Among them, the BBMP and the state government have suggested hospitalization for only 600 patients. Others have got admitted to private hospitals on their own and are spending their own money," he said.

The Chief Commissioner has said that the duration of home isolation has been reduced to seven days from 10 days. "People who suffer from fever, cough and other symptoms have to have an RT-PCR test and isolate themselves till they get the result. It

will prevent the virus from spreading to others. I want to make it clear that all symptoms are not Covid symptoms," he said.

According to him, the BBMP has made arrangements at ward level to treat people who have tested positive for Covid. "Triaging facilities have been made in all wards not only to treat people but also advise hospitalization if it is required. The BBMP has opened ward rooms in all zones and triage centers in each of the 198 wards and control rooms in at Assembly constituencies in the city," he said.

The BBMP Chief Commissioner has appealed to the public to wear face masks to prevent the spread of the virus. "We have created awareness on the importance of wearing face masks," he said.

## Burglars rob doctor's family at gun point

Suddenly the four robbers forcibly entered the house and threatened the occupants at gunpoint and made them to sit at one place. All the four were speaking in Hindi," the SP added.

Fingerprints have been collected from the scene of crime and portraits of the four accused are being done based on the victim's version.

The police are also checking the CCTV footage of the vicinity to get more clues about the gang and also past incidents with similar modus operandi.

The Devanahalli police has registered a case of robbery and are further investigating.

## A lot lake love

### Highlights

Citizens can now directly approach National Green Tribunal if complaints regarding lakes go unheard, unattended or unresolved at civic body level  
Joint committee with KSPCB as nodal agency for coordination, compliance

Going by the directive of the National Green Tribunal's (NGT) principal bench to the authorities concerned, lake activists and citizens need not give up their efforts to make Bruhat Bengaluru Mahanagara Palike's (BBMP) lakes department discharge official duties.

They can now approach the NGT for a suitable direction to the authorities concerned.

NGT's principal bench directed the authorities, including the BBMP, Bengaluru Urban deputy commissioner, State Wetland Authority and Karnataka State Pollution Control Board to constitute a joint committee to have a factual and action taken report, after taking cognisance of a petition filed by Vilasini Ramkumar and others.

The petition was filed against the failure of the authorities concerned to prevent encroachment of the Kembattahalli Lake wetland by some people who wanted to convert the wetland into a burial ground.

"The NGT principal bench registered a suo moto case, based on e-mails sent to it while also sending the same to the BBMP and other authorities. I complained to the BBMP lakes department several times but no action was taken to prevent the encroachment of the lake's wetland," said Vilasini Ramkumar.

She said BBMP lakes department initially did nothing to develop the lake but now the civic body has taken up development of the lake.

The BBMP had allocated Rs 3 crore for the development of Kembattahalli Lake in January 2021. However, it remained oblivious to the construction of the compound wall of the adjacent burial ground on the wetland in August 2021. After residents lodged a complaint, the BBMP lakes department demolished the compound wall.

The NGT principal bench heard the petition on May 6, 2022, and passed an order to constitute a joint committee with Karnataka State Pollution Control Board as the nodal agency for coordination and compliance.

“Factual and action taken report may be furnished within two months by e-mail at [judicial-ngt@gov.in](mailto:judicial-ngt@gov.in) preferably in the form of searchable PDF/OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF. List the matter for further consideration on July 28, 2022,” the NGT order said.

The NGT Principal Bench, headed by Justice Arun Kumar Tyagi and expert member Afroz Ahmad, said that a copy of this order, along with a copy of the complaint, be forwarded to the State Wetland Authority, KSPCB, BBMP chief commissioner and Bengaluru Urban deputy commissioner.

Raghunandan KV, a resident, welcomed the NGT directive and alleged that the BBMP lakes department had neglected the lake for quite a long time. “After NGT principal bench’s directive, the BBMP lakes department has become active and taken up some developmental works at the lake,” said Raghunandan.

Shailesh Charati, a resident, said local citizens have been working to protect the Kembattahalli Lake for three to four years — the lake got funds in 2020 itself but work started only this year after many follow ups. He said the lake has a fence built by the BDA which has been cut open at many places and a road has been laid through the lake area.

“An illegal burial ground has also appeared. Requests to the BBMP to clear the encroachments had gone unheeded; so did requests to the revenue department. In fact, the BBMP created a development plan for the lake leaving out the illegal graveyard while they should have cleared encroachments first.

Requests to maintain the status quo - not allow any more burial and construction of structures after burial by closing the illegal openings in the fence - were not paid any attention,” he said.

According to Charati, earlier encroachment attempts were generally made at night but this year suddenly they became more frequent and were done in broad daylight: the police were called in on some occasions but that did not help either.

“Finally the National Green Tribunal stepped in after complaints were sent to the authority through email. It registered a case based on an e-mail complaint and issued an order to constitute a committee with KSPCB chairman as convener and Karnataka Lake Conservation and Development Authority, BBMP chief commissioner and Bengaluru Urban DC as members.

After this order one entry to the burial ground was closed and we also saw a home guard stationed in the lake," he said.

## Kembattahalli Lake is shrinking, according to official records

The Kembattahalli Lake in Thalaghattapura, whose cause activists took up two years ago, has been shrinking according to official records.

The lake has shrunk from 7.5 acres to less than 6.5 acres, according to the latest survey. Residents of Kothanur and Kembattahalli said the lake sprawled over eight acres in its prime days, but surveyors shrunk its size either accidentally or by design.

In 2016, the Bangalore Development Authority (BDA) measured the lake's spread as eight acres, but the latest survey on July 14, 2022, states that the waterbody is spread over six acres and 16 guntas.

The lake straddles Kembattahalli and Kothanur in Uttarahalli hobli. This includes three encroachments: a temple (12 guntas) and two burial grounds measuring 1 acre 8 guntas and 20 guntas, respectively.

But encroachments mentioned in the July 13, 2015 survey — 19.5 guntas of road and two 0.5 guntas by Anil Kumar and Venkatesh — have disappeared from the records. The 2015 survey also measured the temple's encroachment to 4.75 guntas, which has now grown nearly three times.

Bengaluru tops in intent to hire in Q2 2022: Report

After sending more than 10 complaints since 2020, residents emailed the National Green tribunal (NGT) detailing official inaction and the extent of the existing encroachments. The latest survey, coming after an NGT order in May, has been hugely disappointing to the residents.

### ‘Handle with care’

A senior Karnataka State Pollution Control Board (KSPCB) official said civic authorities all but forgot the lake until 10 years ago. “Encroachments began a long time ago,” the official said. “Villagers who had no place to bury or cremate the dead began using a part of the lake land. It has now become a sensitive matter and must be handled carefully.”

The issue surfaced in July when the joint committee to the lake visited the area. Villagers spoke about their connection to the burial ground in the lake and urged officials not to fence the land.

A committee member said revenue authorities agreed to provide them a two-acre alternative land. “But the issue of existing encroachment has been left for the higher-ups to handle. There were emotional scenes during the committee’s visit. Reclaiming the land may be difficult,” he said.

While a diversion drain has been built to stop sewage from entering the lake, the KSPCB official stressed on the need to monitor the stormwater drain. “A wetland-type structure has to be built to stop the entry of the organic and inorganic waste material into the lake,” he further noted.


