

Report in form of Affidavit by the Ex- Officio Chairman /District Magistrate and  
Collector , District Ganga Protection Committee, Murshidabad (WB)

I, Rajarshi Mitra, son of Sri Manotosh Mitra, aged about 40 years, by faith-Hindu, by Nationality-Indian, by occupation-Service, presently working for gain as the District Magistrate & Collector Ex- Officio Chairman of the District Ganga Protection Committee, Murshidabad, PIN-742101, do hereby solemnly affirm and state as follows: -

1. That I am the Ex- Officio Chairman /District Magistrate and Collector , District Ganga Protection Committee, Murshidabad (WB), presently working for gain in Murshidabad Collectorate, Murshidabad, is well aware of the facts and circumstances of the present original application and I am filing this report in the form of affidavit.
2. That at the very outset, I humbly submit that I have and always had the highest regard to the majesty and dignity of this Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi and I have always acted in due compliance with the Solemn Order dated 25.09.2023 & Order Dated 24.11.2023 O.A No. 200/2014, C.W.P No. 3727/1985 & I.A No. 340/2022



as passed by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi to the best of my ability.

3. That Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, passed an observation in paragraph No. 8 of the order dated 25/09/2023 that at the district level, District Magistrate is the Ex-Officio Chairman of the District Ganga Protection Committee which have been entrusted with certain vital responsibilities for preventing pollution in Ganga at the District level. Hence, at this stage, the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi has directed the District Magistrate all (mainstream and tributaries) from where mainstream of river Ganga as also its tributaries flow in the State of West Bengal to submit their own separate reports on the issues noted above in respect of steps which have been taken by respective District Ganga Protection Committee for prevention and control of pollution of river Ganga in their respective areas.
4. That in compliance with the Solemn Order dated 25.09.2023 mentioned supra, passed by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi, the Program Director of West Bengal State NGRBA Program Management Group (WBSPMG) had sent a letter being Memo No. 5173-NGRBA/SPMG/OA No. 200-762/2023 Dated 03/11/2023 addressed to the Chairperson- Murshidabad District Ganga Protection Committee along with 8 number of Chairpersons in different Districts and separate "TEMPLATE FOR COMPLIANCE UNDER OA 200" inter-alia mentioned that only the information required in Point no. 8 (consisting of different sub-paras mentioned a to h) mentioned in separate "TEMPLATE FOR COMPLIANCE UNDER OA 200" will be filled by the Individual DGPC and the individual Report so prepared is required to be submitted to Hon'ble NGT by each DGPC through its Ex-Officio Chairperson (District Magistrate).

Resolution of the meeting on District Ganga Committee  
(Held on 07.01.2020 at Chamber of the ADM General Murshidabad)

ADM (General), Murshidabad, took the chair and the initiated discussion. The following resolutions were taken:

1. OC (Municipal Affairs) informed that 65 Gram Panchayats from 13 Blocks and 5 Municipalities (namely Berhampore, Murshidabad, Jiaganj-Azimganj, Dhuliyani and Jangipur) lie on either side of Ganga River in the district.
2. Making both all blocks and Municipalities besides the river ODF was one of the major targets.
  - I. For GPs, Secretary, Murshidabad Zilla Parishad informed that more than 180000 individual household toilets have been constructed in 65 Gram Panchayats and all the GPs are ODF now. Further, it is also informed that 51 Community Toilets have been set up in 37 GPs.
  - II. For municipal areas, it was informed that all the 5 municipalities have achieved their target of IHL construction. OC (MA) was directed to follow-up with municipalities to ensure CTs are constructed wherever required. A survey of ghat areas shall be undertaken through municipalities to determine need for community toilet or not.
3. For Liquid waste effluents being discharged into the river Secretary MZP is requested to provide details of GPs already covered under SLWM plants.
4. It is informed the all the Nalas (63) from municipalities to the river have been screened. But only screening cannot give desired result, and at the same time, life of the screens are also to be checked regularly. The municipalities are thus requested to check the screens and remove waste regularly. OC MA shall monitor the progress on this point.
5. The PCB was requested to test the quality of affluent water that is discharged in the Ganga; Help of Berhampore Girls College may be taken in this testing. Water Quality Testing Report on all \_\_ points of discharge of 63 nalas shall be provided in 1 month.
6. Afforestation: Since one of the objectives of the program is to ensure proactive afforestation along river banks; Executive Irrigation is requested to provide list of suitable plots of land available for the same. ADFO agreed to readily provide sapling of suitable species for the drive. This report is expected in 15 days time.
7. It is decided that all the 13 blocks will be instructed to send information regarding Electric Crematorium in the river basin. They also send land particular where electric crematorium may be set up. They will be requested to include medicinal plantation in their NREGS planning, at least one in each block.
8. It was resolved that in the next meeting Executive Officers of the 5 municipalities will be invited to the meeting.

The meeting concluded with thanks from the chair.



The meeting was held on VC mode. The following issues were discussed in the meeting

**1. Waste water treatment Plant(STP):**

Waste water treatment Plant at Berhampore and Jangipur Municipality are being implemented by KMDA GAP wings. The work in both municipalities is going smoothly. It is expected that the project will be completed within August 2023. It is felt to hold a meeting with Deputy Superintendent Of Police (Traffic), Kolkata Metropolitan Development Authority (KMDA) and District Administration immediately as some manholes to be constructed in some places in between Bot -tala to Lifting Station near Circuit House.

It was informed by the Executive Engineer , KMDA that only 1.6 Km out of 5 Km pipeline for STP has been laid so far in Berhampore.

FSTP is being planned in Dhulian Municipality by KMDA GAP. ADM Murshidabad has said that FSTP will not be sufficient for a municipality like Dhulian. The land issue may be taken by the district if required. Accordingly EE KMDA was requested to hold DPR for FSTP for a while.

It was informed by the EE PHED that there is an old STP at Murshidabad Municipality. The department can not run the STP for want of fund. On the other hand KMDA has already prepared a DPR for STP in Murshidabad. Both the Sector decided to share the land details and technicalities of old STP.

2. WBSPMG team has recently visited the crematorium at Brhampore Gorabazar which is supposed to be completed within 31<sup>st</sup> December.

A crematorium is sanctioned in Sujapur which will be maintained by the Beldanga Municipality.

3. The Executive Engineer Ganga Anti Erosion Division I informed that they need fund for some anti Erosion work in the bank of river Bhagirathi but the department has a fund crunch presently . They want to place the proposal to WBSPMG if admitted. It was discussed that this could be communicated to WBSPMG, if they could look into.

It is expected that the project will be completed within August 2023. Work of construction of manholes has been started in Berhampore between Bot -tala to Lifting Station near Circuit House.

It was informed by the Executive Engineer, KMDA that only 3.2 Km out of 5.8 Km pipeline for STP has been laid so far in Berhampore. The length of such laying in Jangipur is 4.5 out of 8 km and in Raghunathganj; it is done 1km out of 5.5 km

**2. Electric Crematorium :**

Both the crematorium in Berhampore is functioning well. A problem in execution of construction work in Kaliganj under Domkal Block has been reported. Subdivision Officer Domkal and Block Develop officer Domkal as well as Block Development officer Jalangi have been requested to short out the problem and make the situation convenient for starting construction work.

**3. Forestation:**

Divisional Forest officer Murshidabad proposed for strip plantation on the river bank. The proposal will be sent to the WBSPMG along with an estimate. Divisional forest officer was requested to take necessary action for preparation of estimate.

**4. IEC :**

It is decided that wall painting will be done for IEC in different places in ULBs especially on Ghats in Berhampore.


**2. Ghat pe Hat in Hazarduari:-**

Progress of work in Berhampore, Jangipur and Raghunathganj is moderate. EE KMDA was requested to construct the LS near ADM (G) Bungalow immediately, otherwise it may be encroached again and may create problem. EE KMDA reported that the construction work of LS at Bot-tola will be started soon. They are requested to apply for road blockage to proper authority immediately for construction work at Bot-tola. Jangipur municipality was requested to issue ROW permission for laying DI pipeline from Shibaji Sangha to Raghunathganj PS immediately so that the STP at Raghunathganj may be completed soon.

4. All municipalities have land for Dumping site, but in case of Jangipur Municipality, the ground is not feasible for dumping ground as it is within close proximity of school etc. The Municipality may purchase suitable land but permission has not been given by the UDMA deptt. EO Jangipur municipality is requested to find out suitable land for this purpose. Process of IDT was clarified to all the municipalities and they were requested to follow the process properly to minimize the time span.
5. All the Municipalities are requested to clear the waste from the screen, installed in Ganga Bound Nalas, regularly.



6. A proposal was raised by the DFO in the last meeting regarding plantation through the river bank, but it is informed that WBSPMG will not allot any fund for this purpose in rural areas. Hence all the Municipalities are requested to find suitable land at river side for more greenery in ULBs. District Administration will pursue for NOC if such land is detected.
7. All the municipalities are requested to send good quality High Resolution Photo on Ganga related works and programme.
8. It is informed to all that an awareness programme will be conduct at KN College Ghat on 14<sup>th</sup> March. Wall painting will be done by school students. All are requested to visit the spot on the scheduled date for making it successful.

Progress of work in Berhampore , Jangiour and Raghunathganj is slow. EE KMDA was requested to speed up the work so that it may be completed within scheduled time.EE KMDA informed that 755 of civil work has been completed in Raghunathganj and Jangipur. He also confirmed that the land problem for setting up of a Lifting Station near DM Bunglow has been resolved in Berhampore.

Proposal for New STP in Murshidabad Muniucipality has been sent and will be sanctioned soon.

KMDA informed that however the problem of executing work along with road ,has been solved but the work cannot be started as some local people creating disturbance.

The mater will be braught under the notice of SP Jangipur and SDO Jangipur for necessary action.

2. A proposal was raised by the DFO in a meeting regarding plantation through the river bank. Accordingly all the Ganga/Bhagirathi bound Municipalities are requested to find out encroachment free govt. land and send proposal to DGC for plantation, along with Land Schedule within 20<sup>th</sup> April.
3. Murshidabad Municipality is requested to take over the existing STP from the PHED as they proposed earlier. They are requested to take up the issue of fund and man power to run the project, with UDMA department.

Divisional Forest Officer initiate the meeting. The following point were discussed in the meeting:

**1. Plantation / Afforestation: -**


- ❖ A proposal was raised by the DFO in a meeting regarding plantation through the river bank. Accordingly, all the Ganga/Bhagirathi bound Municipalities / PWD departments are requested to find out govt. land for plantation. He also informed that In Jalangi Block afforestation has been started by the forest department to combat the erosion in Ganga. the stretch of land is 560 Mts.
- ❖ He also informed that massive plantation drive / Ban Mahatsav will be celebrated from 14<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> July'23 with the involvement of Schools, Colleges, Police Departments & Forest Departments.
- ❖ All municipalities were requested to send land details for plantation. The land should be in the name of Govt. NOC will be required in case of any departmental land.

**2. Public Awareness / Ganga Gram: -**

- ❖ A proposal was raised by the OC (Municipal Affairs) in the meeting regarding IEC programs in 5 Municipalities which are adjacent to the river Ganga & may involve Schools, Colleges, NYKS. The Municipalities accept the proposal.
- ❖ The DPO (Namami Gange) proposed to involve the Gram panchayets in IEC programme in the meeting as because the local Gram Panchayets known as Ganga Gram may play a vital role in public awareness generation of Ganga grams under this project all over the Murshidabad district, they may be coordinated with the Municipalities as well and village level Gangadoots (trained), NGO's may be included along with Schools, Colleges, Police Departments & Forest Departments also. The proposal was accepted.

**3. Ganga Anti Erosion: -**

- ❖ Representative of Ganga Anti Erosion Division informed that two nos anti erosion works were taken up in the year 2022, one at Jalangi Block & another one at Bhagwangola I Block to save the habitation from erosion of river Ganga – Padma. The protection works at Jalangi Block already completed & another one at Bhagwangola I Block is ongoing. There is no




such case of shifting of habitation due to erosion of river Ganga – Padma in the Blocks – Bhagwangola I & II, Raninagar II & Jalangi in the recent times. Ganga Anti Erosion Deptt informed that protection work is taken in four blocks namely Bhagobangola I & II, Jalangi and Raninagar I in this year 2023. Proposal for anti-Erosion work in Azimganj (200 mt) and Jiaganj (500) has been sent to the deptt of anti-erosion. But till no action taken.

❖ EE KMDA informed that overall Physical Progress of the Berhampore - Jangipur STP project is 43.5%.

- i) Almost 75% of the sewerage network has already been laid at different stretches of Berhampore Town. All pumping stations and STP are under progress at Berhampore Town.
- ii) 80% of Civil work at Jangipur STP has been completed. Pumping stations are under construction. The Sewerage network at Jangipur Town is almost 70% completed.
- iii) 75% of Civil work at Raghunathganj STP has been completed. Construction works for Pumping stations are yet to be started. 10% of the Sewerage network at Raghunathganj town completed till date.
- iv) Laying of the sewerage network at Jangipur municipality has been stopped repeatedly due to local agitation. Cooperation from the Jangipur municipality is required to complete the balance work at Jangipur municipality. According in this connection Jangipur municipality was requested to take up the agitation issue with The SDO Jangipur, if required.
- v) ROW permission for laying sewerage network from Jangipur municipality through Tulshi bari from Shashthitala to Raghunathganj Police Station at Raghunathganj is awaited till date. Early issuance of ROW can expedite the work progress. Jangipur municipality was requested to issue NOC in this regard.

❖ KMDA raised another issue that the DPR for the newly proposed 4 MLD STP at Murshidabad Town has been returned by NMCG (Approving Authority) to KMDA due to not considering the existing 1.97 MLD STP which is under the jurisdiction of PHED. All documents related to the existing 1.97MLD WSP at Murshidabad Town are required for DPR preparation by KMDA. The matter was already discussed in the earlier meeting also. District Administration assured to provide the data through PHED for preparation of the DPR at the earliest. KMDA will comply with the same after receiving the data. EE PHED was requested to process to hand over the project as well as all document to the municipality immediately A copy of compliance be sent at the end.

KMDA has requested Dhuliyian Municipality for providing the required land for setting up STP and pumping stations or FSTP for pollution abatement of river Ganga but no response has been received till date. Due to the non-availability of required land at Dhuliyian Municipality, the DPR could not be framed till date by KMDA. KMDA has no other option but to stop the preparation of the DPR for Dhuliyian STP. Dhuliyian municipality was requested to pursue the matter with District Administration.




#### 4. Biodiversity / Wetland & Small River Rejuvenation: -

- ❖ In this meeting a proposal was raised by The DFO regarding Wetland / Biodiversity issues which may be created as the Biodiversity Heritage site in Farakka (for Bird center), Ahiran in Suti I (for Migratory Bird center) & Jiaganj.
- ❖ He also informed about The Dolphin Project. He also expressed his desire to involve those village level Gangadoots under this project in future. DFO proposes three sites in Murshidabad which may be upgraded as Bio diversity heritage place. Those are Jangipur, Farakka and Ahiran.

#### Ghat pe Hat: -

- ❖ Berhampore Div II was requested to prepare an Estimate for permanent structure for Ghat pe Hat.in Murshidabad Municipality. Murshidabad Municipality was requested to arrange a place for Ghat pe Hat.

Additional District Magistrate (General) initiate the meeting. The following point were discussed in the meeting:

- ❖ All 5 Municipalities were directed to provide educational institutions(colleges) list for the conduction of IEC/ Behavioral Change Communication Program out of which only Jiaganj – Azimganj Municipality have been send this details rest Berhampore, Murshidabad, Jangipur & Dhuliyen Municipalities were directed to send pending details of educational institutions at the earliest.
- ❖ In last DGC meeting (June'23) all 5 Municipalities were directed to send land details for afforestation out of which Berhampore & Jangipur Municipalities have been send the details rest Murshidabad, Dhuliyen & Jiaganj - Azimganj Municipalities were again directed to send pending land details for afforestation as early as possible. The land should be in the name of Govt. NOC will be required in case of any departmental land.
- ❖ A proposal was raised by the ADM(G) in a meeting regarding small area plantation involving students of schools & colleges under Namami Gange Project in coordination with Forest department. Proposal was accepted by DFO.
- ❖ DFO informed that in Murshidabad district there are only 1.5% forest exists which is situated in Nabagram, Farakka & Domkol Blocks. He also informed that Dolphin & Gharial conservation has been carried out at Berhampore Natun ghat.
- ❖ EE KMDA informed that overall Physical Progress of the Berhampore - Jangipur STP project is 47.5%.
  - (I) **In case of Berhampore STP:**
    - **Berhampore STP:** Nearly 55% of the Civil work is complete.
    - **Sewerage Network:** Approx 80% of the sewerage network has been completed.
    - **Pumping Stations:**
      - Lifting station near DM Bungalow: 39% completed.
      - Lifting Station at Kaplier Math: 39% Completed.
      - UGLS at Battala: 50% completed.



➤ Issues:

- The removal of temporary encroachment near DM Bungalow Lifting Station is required to facilitate sewerage network connection. Berhampore Municipality is requested to address this promptly.
- Clearance of encroachment at Berhampore STP is essential for boundary wall construction and drainage reconstruction. Berhampore Municipality's intervention is needed to expedite this process.
- Addressing the space constraint for construction material stacking at Berhampore STP, a proposal to use the vacant area under Dasmundu Kali Bari as a stack yard has been suggested. Berhampore Municipality's consideration is requested.
- Completion of sewerage network work at Berhampore Town is impeded by challenging conditions near Khagra Samsan Ghat, where the pipeline is being laid at depths of 4-5 meters.

❖ In this context KMDA should coordinate with Berhampore Municipality to ensure swift completion of STP project of their jurisdiction.

• (II) In case of Jangipur STP:

- **Jangipur STP:** Almost 82% Civil work completed.
- **Sewerage Network:** Almost 85% completed.
- **Pumping Stations:**
  - Lifting station near Municipal Go down: 39% completed.
- **Issues:**
  - Frequent disruptions by local residents and halts during events like Eid-UL Fittr, Maharam, and Panchayat Election have impacted pipeline work. Thefts of construction materials are recurring issues, and local communities are posing threats to the agency. Cooperation from Jangipur Municipality is crucial to expedite the project.

❖ In this context Jangipur Municipality are requested to look into this matter & ensure full cooperation regarding some local issues / agitations which is raised by KMDA at earliest for successful completion of STP project of their jurisdiction

• (III) In case of Raghunathganj STP:

- **Raghunathganj STP:** Almost 80% civil work completed.
- **Sewerage Network:** Almost 15% completed.
- **Pumping Stations:**
  - Lifting station near Global More: 35% completed.
  - UGLS at Balighata: 5% Completed.
  - UGLS at Shibaji Sangha: 5% Completed.



- (IV) KMDA reported that the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the proposed 4 MLD STP at Murshidabad Town was returned by NMCG due to the absence of consideration for the existing 1.97 MLD STP under PHED jurisdiction. All documents pertaining to the existing 1.97 MLD WSP are required for DPR preparation. District Administration assured to provide the necessary data via PHED to facilitate DPR preparation by KMDA.
- ❖ In this context PHED department are directed to provide pending present status of existing WSP at Murshidabad Municipal Town to the undersigned in order to successfully prepare the DPR for Interception & Diversion with STP at Murshidabad Town by KMDA on an urgent note.
- (V) KMDA has formally requested Dhuliyani Municipality for the necessary land for the STP and pumping stations or an FSTP to address Ganga River pollution. Despite repeated requests, no response has been received. Due to the unavailability of land in Dhuliyani Municipality, the DPR preparation has been stalled. KMDA has further requested to Dhuliyani Municipality to provide an alternative land of 0.78 acres for the FSTP. However, no response has been received from Dhuliyani Municipality. KMDA is left with no choice but to halt the DPR preparation if the required land is not provided.
- ❖ Berhampore Municipality informed that all Screenings, Ganga Heritage Park including River front development have been completed. They are directed to ensure that no waste materials enter the Ganga River.
- ❖ The meeting was closed conveying thanks to all concerned.



  - Banners poster have bben disply allk the Ganga Ghats for awareness of the people not to throw any plastic, thermocol, organic waste etc in the river Ganga and all the ghats are regularly cleaned for control of pollution of river Ganga.
  - No such cases are found at the river bank.
