Sub.: Hon'ble NGT order dated 20/02/2023 (O.A. No. 890/2022) News articles published in "Dainik Bhaskar Dated-14-11-2022 with regard to "Garbage heap; garbage piled up in the city Balrampur toxic smoke coming out of fire in OA no. 890/2022.

Hon'ble Sir,

That the Hon'ble NGT has passed the order in OA No. 890/2022 on dated 20/02/2023 in the matter of News articles published in "Dainik Bhaskar Dated-14-11-2022 with regard to "Garbage heap; garbage piled up in the city Balrampur toxic smoke coming out of fire.

"....3. In our view a substantial question relating to environment due to implementation of Schedule enactments under NGT Act, 2010 has arisen but before taking further action, we find it appropriate to obtain a factual report for the purpose thereof we constitute a Joint Committee comprising State PCB and District Magistrate, Balrampur who shall visit the site, collect relevant information and submit a factual report within two months.

4. The Committee shall also report about action taken if any which need to include prohibition of open dumping and clearing remaining 2sites. Nagar Palika Balrampur (Adarsh Nagar Palika) may also indicate on setting up and operation of waste processing facility and not creating legacy waste dumping sites which shall also be a part of the said report.

5. The District Magistrate shall be nodal agency for coordination and compliance.

6. The said Committee shall submit an action taken report within three months with the Registrar General of this Tribunal who shall place the report before the Bench if find necessary for any further order.

7. The report shall be submitted by e-mail at judicialngt@gov.in preferably in the form of searchable PDF/ OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF.

8. List this matter on 26.04.2023.."

Joint Committee Inspection/Factual Report of dumping sites(Legacy Waste) Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur in the matter of News articles published in "Dainik Bhaskar Dated- 14.11.2022 with regard to "Garbage heap; garbage piled up in the city Balrampur toxic smoke coming out of fire.in OA no. 890/2022

Background

Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi vide its order dated 20.02.2023 in the matter of matter of News articles published in "Dainik Bhaskar Dated- 14.11.2022 with regard to "Garbage heap; garbage piled up in the city Balrampur toxic smoke coming out of fire. in the matter of O.A. No. 890/2022 to ascertain the factual position and take remedial action in accordance of law. Relevant para of Hon'ble NGT order is as under-

"....3. In our view a substantial question relating to environment due to implementation of Schedule enactments under NGT Act, 2010 has arisen but before taking further action, we find it appropriate to obtain a factual report for the purpose thereof we constitute a Joint Committee comprising State PCB and District Magistrate, Balrampur who shall visit the site, collect relevant information and submit a factual report within two months.

4. The Committee shall also report about action taken if any which need to include prohibition of open dumping and clearing remaining 2sites. Nagar Palika Balrampur (Adarsh Nagar Palika) may also indicate on setting up and operation of waste processing facility and not creating legacy waste dumping sites which shall also be a part of the said report.

5. The District Magistrate shall be nodal agency for coordination and compliance.

6. The said Committee shall submit an action taken report within three months with the Registrar General of this Tribunal who shall place the report before the Bench if find necessary for any further order.

7. The report shall be submitted by e-mail at judicialngt@gov.in preferably in the form of searchable PDF/ OCR Support PDF and not in the form of Image PDF.

B. Observations:

1- During the inspection, the Joint Committee found the 04 Municipal Solid Waste Dumping site in Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur.

- i. **South direction from Tulsipur road, near Mevalal Police Chauki (adjacent to MRF Centre) in Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur:-(Latitude-27.432307, Longitude-82.0195157):-**

Total MSW dumping site area is approx 1.430 hectare and estimated Municipal Solid Waste (legacy waste) dumped is approx 3550 tonnes. Dumping yard is there since approx 03 years and this dumping site is just adjacent to MRF Facility. The MRF Center is built on the land situated in the South direction from Tulsipur Road near Mevalal Police Chowki in Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur. Presently the garbage dumping work is closed at this site and legacy waste covered with ash.

As per information provided by NPP balrampur, MRF Facility is not functional as Status quo has been imposed by the order dated 19.08.2021 passed in the Hon'ble High Court in Conciliation writ No.-17998 of 2021.

- ii. **Baluwa Mohalla, Between Girl Inter College to Nahar Balaganj Road, Muralipur, Balrampur:-(Latitude-27.419647, Longitude-82.184728):-**

In Baluwa Mohalla, Muralipur Total MSW dumping site area is approx 3000 square meters. estimated Municipal Solid Waste (legacy waste) dumped approx 2700 tonnes. Dumping yard is there since approx 15 years. Presently the garbage dumping work is closed at this site and the legacy waste is found covered with ash. No treatment facility is available at site and legacy waste covered with ash.

iii. **Suvav Drain/River, Barrage, Balrampur:- (Latitude-27.420226, Longitude-82.169476):-**

Total MSW dumping site area is approx 800 square meters and estimated Municipal Solid Waste (legacy waste) dumped approx 1200 tonnes. Dumping yard is there since approx 08 years. Presently the garbage dumping work is closed at this site and the legacy waste was found covered with ash. No treatment facility available at site.

iv. **Mevalal Talab (Before Ranjitpur Drain), Mevalal Police Chauki, Tulsipur Road, Balrampur:- (Latitude-27.433028, Longitude-82.196218):-**

Total MSW dumping site area is approx 4000 square meters and estimated Municipal Solid Waste (legacy waste) dumped is approx. 50 tonnes. Dumping yard is there since Approx 02 month. Presently the garbage dumping work is continuing at this site and no treatment facility is available at site. During inspection burning of garbage was found in the dumping yard site.

- 2- During visit the Joint Committee observed huge amount of legacy waste in all 04 dumping sites accumulated over a period of time. In view of huge amount of legacy waste existing at the proposed site, proposal for disposal / treatment of this waste should strictly comply with the provision of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 3- The Joint Committee observed that decomposition of organic waste being dumped leads to formation of Methane which often burns and there is continuous emission of smoke / poisonous gases and fine particulate matter. The Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur shall ensure reduction of emission of Methane generated from the MSW legacy waste due to continuous burning of plastics and other combustible waste.
- 4- All 04 dumping sites do not have proper leachate management system and it may affect the groundwater of nearby area adversely. Therefore, it is desired that the facility should develop and implement an effective leachate management system as per the provision of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 5- There is movement of large no. of truck, tractor and other vehicle carrying MSW on the dusty roads and this results into re-suspension of dust thereby causing Air Pollution beside vehicle exhaust emissions. The Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur shall ensure proper maintenance of these vehicle and arrangement of water sprinkling system for the control of dust suspension.
- 6- The team noticed that waste received at site was not segregated. It reveals that segregation at source is not being practiced. The Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur should develop proper collection system to segregate waste at source.
- 7- Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur has not installed any arrangement for safe and scientific disposal of municipal solid waste generated from Urban area.

C. Recommendation:-

- 1- It is recommended that the Legacy Waste lying in all the 4 dumping yards / Legacy Waste sites should be disposed off (Bio-remediation / Bio-Mining) by preparation of an Action Plan by the Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur.
- 2- It is recommended that For disposal of Municipal Solid Waste generated from the Nagar Palika Parishad, Balrampur area, construction of integrated Municipal Solid Waste disposal facility should be done by preparing an time bound Action Plan.

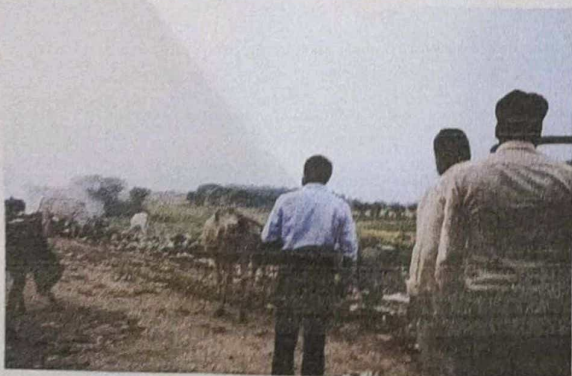
