



I, the above named deponent do hereby solemnly affirm and declare as under:-

1. That the above noted Original Application is pending adjudication before this Hon'ble National Green Tribunal and is now fixed for hearing on 14.08.2025.
2. That at the very outset, it is most respectfully submitted that the deponent has the highest regard for this Hon'ble Tribunal as well as the orders passed by it and holds it in the highest esteem. He considers his first and foremost duty to uphold the majesty and dignity of law and to comply with each and every direction issued from time to time and to bring the true facts/exact position into the notice of this Hon'ble Tribunal and cannot even think of disobeying any order or conceal any facts willfully or intentionally from this Hon'ble Tribunal or any other competent court of law.
3. That, due to having utmost regard of this Hon'ble Tribunal, in compliance of all the previous orders, the requisite information as sought from time to time, was got provided by the deponent by filing his affidavit /additional affidavit and the same may please be read as part of this affidavit to avoid repetition. However, as this Hon'ble Tribunal was not satisfied with the information which was got provided by the deponent, due to which, now again vide its order dated 15.04.2025, has been pleased to direct the deponent to place on record a copy of the original document containing the details of the species/nature of 2023 plants /trees which were planted in the year 2020-2021&2021-2022, and the exact details about cutting of these plants/trees. The operative part of the order dated 15.04.2025, of this Hon'ble Tribunal is as under:-





“4. The above information reveals that though the plantation was done in the year 2021 and the cutting/felling was done after a lapse of time but it does not disclose as to how many of them had become the trees. The DFO, Gurdaspur, appearing virtually, has not furnished the complete and correct information relating to the felling of trees. The DFO could not explain this and has sought time to file a further supplementary affidavit. He is directed to place on record a copy of the original document containing the details of the species/nature of 2023 plants /trees which were planted in the year 2020-2021, and the exact details of the cutting of these plants/trees.

5. List on 14.08.2025.”

4. That, in compliance of the above order dated 15.04.2025, it is most respectfully submitted that in pursuant to the previous order dated 27.01.2025, the concerned Forest Range Officer vide his spot inspection report, had informed that the total number of plants planted on both sides of the road Km 42.960 to Km 44.100 during year 2020-21 was 2023 and out of these plants, a total number of 1651 plants were cut by National Highway Authority of India during the construction of the bridge and now 372 Plants are standing at the site. Because this information was not found to be completed as required, the office of the deponent vide his office letter/order No. 266 dated 21-04-2025 and letter No. 553 dated 09-05-2025 directed to the concerned Forest Range Officer, to submit his detailed spot inspection report after visiting and collecting all the requisite information as sought by this Hon'ble Tribunal. In pursuant to the above office letter/order, the concerned Forest Range officer on 18.05.2025, after visiting and collecting all the requisite information as has been sought by this Hon'ble Tribunal, while giving the details of the species/nature of 2023 plants/trees which were planted in the year 2020-2021 & 2021-22, and the exact details of the cutting and standing of these plants/trees, prepared his detailed spot inspection report in the form of table.

5. That in the humble understanding of the deponent, the above mentioned information is sufficient which has been sought by this Hon'ble Tribunal and was not given in the earlier affidavits due to not understating the order in its true perspective. This mistake was neither intentionally nor deliberately and there was no purpose to conceal it on the part of the deponent, it was only inadvertent mistake, for which the deponent sincerely regrets and tenders an unqualified and an unconditional apology for the inconvenience caused to this Hon'ble Tribunal and assures to be remained more vigilant in future and further undertakes to comply with all the directions issued at any time. The deponent further undertakes to comply with all the directions which would issued in future.
6. That in compliance of above said order dated 15.04.2025 of this Hon'ble Tribunal, this short affidavit is being filed.



It is, therefore, humbly prayed that this information may kindly be taken on record and an appropriate order may kindly be passed, in the interest of justice, equity and fair play.
