

Hon'ble Sir,

1. We had filed a petition No. 196/2022, with regard to dumping of hazardous municipal wastes into Green Belt of Ansal East End, Trans Delhi Signature City, Ghaziabad 201103, by Nagar Palika Parishad, Loni.
2. Hon'ble National Green Tribunal order dated 11/03/2022, directed to form a Joint Committee of the State Pollution Control Board, District Magistrate & DFO, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh to meet within 4 weeks' time, and visit the site to ascertain the facts within 3 months' time.
3. However, the Pollution Control Board submitted their report on 21/11/22 i.e. late by about 5 months.
4. The report supports our complaint that:
 - i. Water logging was found
 - ii. Large number of trees were found dried
 - iii. Garbage was found dumped by the municipality
 - iv. Waterlogging was there for a long time.
5. The Report submitted by PCB states that they have sent their letter dated 27/06/2022, addressed to Executive Officer, Nagar Palika Parishad, recommending to stop dumping of hazardous municipal wastes into Green Belt.
6. The Nagar Palika Parishad has not taken any action and they continue to dump hazardous wastes / sewage into the Green Belt and they have submitted false and fabricated compliance report only to confuse this Hon'ble Tribunal.




PRAYER
